Covid:

Please travel to the event alone. Spectators/coaches/drivers will not be allowed in the sports Hall No Spectators aloud in the building. This is to meet AGB/government and Brunel Commercial guidelines for groups of people and social distancing. Left handers will shoot to the left of their distance to avoid facing right-handed Archers.

You should ask yourself the following questions before attending:

- •Do you have a high temperature? Yes/No
- •Do you have a new, continuous cough? Yes/No
- •Do you have a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste? Yes/No
- •Are you in a household or bubble with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 in the past 14 days? Yes/No
- •Are you in a lockdown area? Yes/No*
- * If you are in an area of a local lockdown/restrictions, you must follow the guidance for your area as these may be slightly different.

If the answer to any of these is yes, then you should not attend the competition.

We will provide details about additional Covid related procedures along with the Target list, a few days before the competition. Unfortunately, lockdowns may also affect HAC, so be prepared just in case we must cancel the Competition at the last minute.

Juniors may be accompanied by a parent/guardian into the Sports Hall, but they must leave and wait in the car outside to ensure that the total number in the Hall does not exceed 25. There will be an appointed Safeguarding office on each session.

Please wait outside on the Blue Feet (Keeping Social distancing) with your membership card ready and do not enter the Building until you have been instructed to by the person(s) that will book you in.

Please provide whatever PPE you feel comfortable with and bring your own hand sanitiser. We will also have sanitiser stations. A First Aider will be present, but to avoid cross contamination please bring your own first aid kit for minor injuries. Remember to report all incidents to the organiser
