When the leaves begin to fall and the brilliant foliage fades, winter days will be upon us and holiday shopping will begin. Shopping in our quaint specialty




shops or our bustling downtown districts will leave you filled with the spirit of the holiday season. You can find gifts for everyone on your list by following

# City sidewalks, busy sidewalks Dressed in holiday style . . .

e're going to start our shopping expedition in Media otherwise known as Everybody's Home Town and the seat of Delaware County. The merchants on State Street always put out their best decorations for the season giving the picturesque illusion of a real-life Currier & Ives print. (The soothing sound of the local trolley rolling down the street periodically certainly helps to complete the picture.) Window shopping is encouraged here, although we're guessing you won't be able to stop at the windows.

Plenty of gifts for the man on your list can be found at B. Gross Menswear, one of the true Media landmarks that line the street. Custom tailoring and personalized service still are the norm here, even after more than 80 years. Across the street and down a few doors is Golden Impulse Jewelers where they have perennial holiday favorites — exquisite, sparkling gifts in tiny, wrapped packages. Need we say more?

Also on State Street is The Village Art Shop. Have an otherwise hard-to-buyfor teenager on your list? Or maybe an imaginative and artistic mom who loves to scrapbook or paint? Purchase some quality papers, pencils or pens here for the gift of creative expression. And, while you're thinking color and design, pop in The Media Florist for a stunning floral centerpiece that will take any holiday gathering from routine to memorable.

Once you've found your treasures along State Street, tuck them safely in your shopping bag and follow Baltimore Pike to Route 1 south toward Chadds Ford.


bout eight miles down the road is the second destination on our journey — The Shoppes at Brinton Lake. More than 25 shops and restaurants are here, providing convenient access to a variety of gift-giving options. Names such as Williams Sonoma, Pottery Barn, Galan Gifts and Fine Furnishings and Pier 1 Imports have festive and practical gifts for the home. If the person you're shopping for is a devoted J. Crew or Eddie Bauer fan, they're here, too, as well as clothiers Ann Taylor Loft, Christopher & Banks, Talbot's, Victoria's Secret and Chico's. It's also possible, while you are here, to get a manicure at the Thomas Lavella Salon, create a homemade pottery gift at Color Me Mine or get a quick treat of ice cream at MaggieMoos. If lunch or dinner is on your mind, Ruby's Diner, The America Bar & Grill and P.F. Chang's Chinese Bistro each have exquisite fare in fun settings — just what you need to feel refreshed to continue shopping.

After Brinton Lake, return to Route 1. heading south. Just down the road is the intersection of Routes 1 and 202. If you take a small detour and turn left onto Route 202 south, plenty of specialty shops await the discriminating gift giver. The first stop, only a mile down the road, could be the brand new Keystone Plaza, home of several shops and Pescatore's Restaurant. Pescatore's — new since July — offers entrees such as pizza, steak, seafood and Italian specialties in a familyfriendly atmosphere reminiscent of the old country. The charming atmosphere, separate bar and private banquet room are sure to make this Brandywine newcomer a favorite destination for years to come.


Just next door to the Keystone Plaza is the entrance to Olde Ridge Village, a collection of charming boutiques nestled in a cozy ring of stone cottages. Shopping here is stressfree and fun and always promises lots of checkmarks on your shopping list — plus a little treat for yourself.


Crafters will enjoy browsing The Stencil Shoppe where you can find multitudes of handmade stencils and lots of ideas on how to use them. From tiny squares to be used on notecards to garden murals that fill entire walls, they have it here. If jewelry making is the craft of choice for special someone, E-Z Beads is where all the locals shop for tools and supplies. A gift certificate for one of their classes would be a great gift here as well.

Almost everyone has little ones on their gift-giving lists, but are you tired of giving unimaginative, heavily marketed, plastic toys from a big-box store? Book Fair is literally crammed with













award-winning toys, challenging games and puzzles — and yes, books - that make even the elves in Santa's workshop envious.

Not all holiday shopping is about gifts. Don't forget that you probably need a few items for the celebration aspect of it all. Be sure to stop at Paper Pickins, for fine stationary such as invitations and thank you notes and the Wine and Beer Emporium for supplies for a truly merry affair.

Across Route 202 from Olde Ridge, is Glen Eagle Square, also home to more than 25 shops and restaurants. Some names here are very familiar, such as Jos. A. Bank Clothiers, Gap, Banana Republic, Ann Taylor and American Eagle Outfitters. Some of the retailers' names may be new to you — for example, Trail Creek Outfitters, Cameo Water Wear, Annie Prue, Mykonos and The Ski Bum — but they could have that perfect something for someone on your list.

From here, shoppers can proceed just a mile or two farther down 202 for a couple of specialty shops that could transform your home into the one that everyone wants to come home to this year. For example, you could bring out some chestnuts and prepare to roast them

at a nostalgic open fireplace, complete with accessories from the Chadds Ford Fireside Shop. Or, remodel your guest room with comfortable and cozy items from either Hunt Country Furniture or Marstan's Unpainted Furniture. (Shopping tip: keep in mind that if you have first-time apartment owners or newlyweds on your list, they would probably appreciate gifts from here, as well!)

After these stops, the next destination is the sparkling shopping district of Kennett Square. Turn around and take Route 202 north to get back to Route 1 south.

Strings of street lights Even stop lights Blink a bright red and green . . .

n your way into Kennett Square, you'll pass Spring Run Natural Foods right on Route 1, just past Longwood Gardens. If your holiday menu calls for high-quality, organic foods or quality vegetarian products, make a quick stop here and stock up on some delicious treats.

Once you've followed the directions above to State Street, find a place to park and explore a town that could double for Bedford Falls in "It's a Wonderful Life" any day. Shopping here is always a delight, but during the holiday season, the local shopkeepers take extra care to put a little of the magic back into the season. Be sure to take your time strolling along the tree-lined avenues and sampling the scents of coffee, cookies and seasonal delights. One place you shouldn't miss is actually two boutiques in one — The Mushroom Cap and The Growing Tree. The owner started The Growing Tree to showcase adorable, personalized children's gifts and consignment items. A few years later, she realized that when visitors asked her where to find Kennett Square mushrooms (Kennett Square is the mushroom capital of the world) she would have to tell them to go to the local Acme. Thus, her second shop — specializing in home-grown, gourmet mushrooms and related

items — was planted and has grown fruitfully ever since.

Hear the snow crunch See the kids bunch This is Santa's big scene . . .

**▼** rom Kennett Square, find Union Street (Route 82) and travel north to 926. Turn right onto 926 east. After driving through some of the prettiest countryside the Brandywine has to offer, you will intersect Route 202 again — also known as Wilmington Pike. At this crossroads, turn south on 202 for 1-1/2 miles to find The Shoppes at Dilworthtown Crossing — yet another location with even more stores from which to choose. For the cigar lover in your family, Old Havanna Cigar Company may have just the right gift — as well as the knowledgeable staff to assist you in your selection. A great idea would be to stop in Kabloom — a European-style flower shop right next door - and pick up several small arrangements to give to the hosts of any holiday gatherings you are attending.

Once you've found your treasures here, turn back onto Route 202 north (you will pass back across 926) and stay on it until you see the sign to split off on to High Street in West Chester. A few blocks past the campus of West Chester University, you will be in the heart of the delightful downtown shopping district, a place that has as

many gifts as the North Pole, but far more pleasurable to walk around.

The shopping choices here are truly almost endless, but we have a few that you might want to make special note to be sure to visit. Adorable, timeless clothes and toys that challenge the imagination — instead of the eardrums — can be found at Play Nice Children's Boutique on Market Street. Down on High Street is the Jane Chalfant Boutique — really three specialty shops in one — where discriminating clients have purchased timeless, stylish fashions and accessories for 74 years. Around the corner on Gay Street is the Newbury Street Design interior design studio with ideas to decorate vour home and over on South Church is Pages Card Shop with ideas to decorate your gifts. Finally, a little farther up on East Gay Street in the Cambridge Square Shopping Center (but worth the trip!) is J. Ryan's Designer Resale Shoppe where you can find, among other things, designer consignment party dresses for all of your seasonal engagements.

On your way out of West Chester, if your path takes you on Route 202 south, don't miss The Abbey Green Shop on your right just out of town. If you're searching for a present for a lover of all things Irish, you won't need a leprechaun to find treasure here — this darling boutique specializes in everything imaginable from the old country such as clothing, jewelry, and gifts.

# Educationally speaking, Brandywine offers something for everyone

very year, without fail, just as the calendar closes on summer and inches toward fall, thousands of students return to the Brandywine to further their education. Whether it be a newly-minted high school graduate entering a traditional four-year college or a retired professional enrolling in a class just to satisfy his curiosity, students of all kinds can be found here, across our countryside, studying, growing and becoming more informed citizens of the world.

Below are some snapshots of our most illustrious institutions. Like snapshots, they may capture the essence of a school, but only scratch the surface of the depth of its personality. The best way to learn about a school is to visit it for yourself. So plan a campus trip to the Brandywine soon. While you are here, you may learn much about our noted





place in American history, but you will also be exploring the limitless opportunities of your future.

# Albright College

Albright College, in Reading, Pennsylvania, strives to provide today's students with a flexible, top-notch education and personalized service. The main campus, founded in 1898 by Jacob Albright, sits on 100 acres in a traditional university setting. However, the new branch campuses — one at the Concordville Hotel in Concordville and one at the Eagleview Corporate Center in Exton —

provide comfortable learning atmospheres in not-so-traditional settings.

Today's students want to know what will be provided to them with their tuition costs and what support they will




receive, says Linda Metzler, enrollment advisor for the accelerated degree programs offered in Exton and Concordville. Albright's five accelerated degree programs meet just one night a week and offer flexibility and convenience while providing accreditation in business administration, applied psychology/organizational behavior, accounting, crime and justice or information systems.

# Cabrini College

The Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus came to the United States to assist immigrants struggling with poverty, discrimination and lack of educational opportunities. With that in mind, they founded Cabrini College as a four-year liberal arts and sciences institution in 1957. The goal of helping others











remains a strong tradition here and the college started a national trend in 1989 when it became the first institution of higher learning in the nation to require community service for graduation, a common practice today.

Cabrini's Center for Graduate and Professional Studies serves the needs of the adult continuing education student and professional with graduate programs as well as accelerated undergraduate programs. Areas of study include education, instructional systems and technology and organizational leadership.

"Cabrini offers exciting opportunities with its master's degree in organizational leadership," explains Colleen Nelson, director of enrollment and recruitment for graduate and professional studies. "Leadership

themes are built into all courses and are integrated across the curriculum so that students develop a comprehensive, consistent, and applicable approach to leading within their organizations. Students apply in-class learning to daily workplace issues."

# Chestnut Hill College

Chestnut Hill College is a four-year, coed, Catholic liberal arts college that provides students with a holistic education in an inclusive Catholic community marked by academic excellence, shared responsibility, personal and professional growth, service and concern for the earth.

Chestnut Hill's 1,800 students can choose from more than 40 undergraduate, graduate or continuing education programs, includ-

ing popular, new offerings in forensic science and computer forensics.

"Chestnut Hill College prides itself on our philosophy of a holistic approach to higher education, seeking to address social, spiritual, physical and cultural needs of students as well as academic ones," says Kathleen Spigelmyer, director of public relations. "Education should emphasize growth of the whole person not only through a liberal arts education, but also through an exciting social life, a healthy spiritual life, and a well-rounded active life, therefore exposing students to the best college has to offer."

# **Cheyney University**

Founded in 1837 as the Institute for Colored Youth,

Cheyney University Pennsylvania is the oldest of the historically black colleges and universities in America. Richard Humphreys, a Quaker philanthropist, bequeathed \$10,000 (only one-tenth of his massive estate) to establish a school to educate the descendents of the African race. The school moved to George Cheyney's farm, 25 miles west of Philadelphia, in 1902 and grew through many name changes until it joined the State System of Higher Education as Cheyney University of Pennsylvania in 1983.

Today, Cheyney students are members of a variety of races, cultures and nationalities representing multiple levels of achievement from a wide range of educational backgrounds. Cheyney offers baccalaureate degrees in

more than 30 disciplines as well as a master's degree in education. Just a few of the school's noted alumni include journalist Ed Bradley of the CBS-TV's "60 Minutes;" Robert W. Bogle, publisher and CEO of the *Philadelphia Tribune*, the oldest newspaper continuously owned and operated by an African-American; and U.S. Rep. Curt Weldon, who represents the 7th Congressional District, which includes Chester and Delaware counties.

# Delaware County Community College

Community colleges across the nation are increasingly attracting discerning students who desire a topnotch, affordable education and Delaware County Community College is no exception. With campuses Township, Marple Broomall, Sharon Hill, Exton and Downingtown, DCCC serves students in both Delaware and Chester counties.

"The role of community colleges is changing," says Marianne K. Rhodes, assistant director of public relations. "We offer low costs, high-quality professional training opportunities and dual enrollment options with four-year colleges and universities.

An example of their flexible educational opportunities is their 2+2+2 program. Students can enroll in DCCC-approved applied

engineering technology classes while juniors and seniors in high school (two years), move on to DCCC and earn an associate's degree in applied science degree in applied engineering technology (two years) and then go on to earn a bachelor's degree in applied engineering technology with Drexel University (two years).

# Delaware County Community College's Malin Road Center

DCCC's campus on Malin Road in Broomall specializes in technical education programs, in a direct response from business and industry seeking out academic institutions that would be willing to listen to their needs and develop relevant programs of study. Many of the school's career and technical programs are articulated with four-year institutions with full credit being applied to earning a bachelor of science degree.

In the area of applied engineering technology, DCCC has gained local, state and national recognition as a "Center for Excellence" that supports industry needs for highly skilled, degreed technicians and technologists in manufacturing, electrical and mechanical disciplines. Believing that communication is the key to creating and implementing successful workforce development programs, DCCC works closely with industry leaders to develop a curriculum that teaches the knowledge and skills required in today's highly technical and specialized workforce.

# **Drexel University**

Drexel University, ranked as one of America's Best Colleges for 2005 by *U.S.* News & World Report, is widely recognized as one of the top 50 private, nonprofit, national doctoral/ research universities in the country. Not only does Drexel offer more than 170 programs of study, it also offers the only mandatory co-op program in Pennsylvania and one of three in the United States.

Drexel's reputation as a technology-rich university is well deserved. In 1983, Drexel became the first university to require all entering students to have microcomputers. In 2000, Drexel became the first major university to operate a fully wireless campus, and in 2002. Drexel launched the first mobile Web portal service for students. Drexel eLearning, the university's online education subsidiary, serves working professionals around the world who want to complete their education without compromising quality for convenience.

# **Eastern University**

Tucked in the landscape of the heart of suburban Philadelphia's Main Line is Eastern University in St. Davids, a Christian institution where the goal is to develop committed professionals who serve the poor and disenfranchised through programs such as economic development and nonprofit management.

American Baptists founded Eastern in 1952 and the university's faculty still reflects both the goal of the founders and the mission statement above. Some of their prestigious faculty includes Tony Campolo, Wilson Goode, Duffy Robbins and Ron Sider, all of whom are well known in Christian and social justice




# JNA Institute

JNA Institute was founded in 1988 and is a leader in culinary arts education. JNA awards Associates degree in Culinary Arts/ Restaurant Management as well as a diploma program in Specialized Foodservice Management. The Institute will also present hands-on cooking events











customized especially for your group and could be ideal as a team-building program.

# Immaculata University

Immaculata University, a Catholic liberal arts institution, is well known for offering a wide variety of liberal arts majors and has strong programs in nutrition/dietetics and music therapy that are receiving recognition on their own.

Founded in 1920 and situated on 375 beautiful acres in Chester County, the school provides small classes and a value-based education that is open to people of all faiths. Students who attend receive the ability to be grounded in the field of their choice and enter the workforce with self confidence in their ability to tackle all challenges, according to Marie E. Moughan, executive director of public relations and marketing.

Some of Immaculata's famous alumnae that live up to that promise include Marie Brown Valdes-Dapena, ('41) a nationallyrecognized Sudden Infant Death Syndrome authority; Theresa Shank Grentz ('74), head women's basketball coach at the University of Illinois and coach of the 1992 Women's Olympic Basketball Team; and Rene Muth Portland ('75), head women's basketball coach at Penn State University. Both Grentz and Portland played together on the first three Immaculata national



championship basketball teams from 1972 through 1974.

# Neumann College

Founded in 1965 by the Sisters of St. Francis of Philadelphia, Neumann College is widely known for its programs in nursing and education. Recently, several popular programs of study have been added, including arts production and performance, criminal justice and sport management. It is the intellectual home of more than 2,600 undergraduate and graduate students, some of whom participate in accelerated degree programs that can be completed in 15, 18 or 24 months.

Says Steven Bell, executive director of marketing and communications for the college: "As a Franciscan institution, Neumann College incorporates the concept of social responsibility and workplace ethics into every program. By investing their education at Neumann, students receive extraordinary personal attention, an emphasis on ethical behavior and excellent academic instruction."

# Pennsylvania Institute of Technology

In 1953, Walter R. Garrison, a practicing engineer, founded the Pennsylvania Institute of Technology to meet a need for trained technicians to assist practicing engineers in performing stress analysis in




the aircraft and civil/architectural fields. Currently, there are more than 300 students enrolled in various programs at PIT, the only two-year, independent college in Pennsylvania that offers associate's degrees and certificate programs in engineering technology, information technology, allied health technology and business administration. Recently, the school added new certificate programs in medical assistant, medical office specialist, and pharmacy technician. Upon completion, students are prepared to sit for the appropriate industry certification examinations.

Ann Smith, director of public affairs, says, "Among all the regionally accredited institutions of higher education in the Brandywine region, the Pennsylvania Institute of Technology stands apart as the technology college of the Delaware Valley in preparing students to enter into the workforce with the required level of technological savvy."

# Pennsylvania State University Delaware County
