- Do not stand directly against the respect barrier instead, stand behind the painted line, to prevent unnecessary contact with surfaces.
- No changing room facilities are available.
- NHS Track and Trace: visiting team officials are responsible for keeping a
 list of their own team's players and spectators in attendance. If an outbreak
 is reported, a Top Score FC official will directly contact the team manager,
 who can then contact his or her own players and family members, to adhere
 to government guidance.
- No dogs allowed at the facility.
- The parking provision at Speedwell Lane is limited so all vehicles MUST enter at the first entrance YELLOW ZONE. (Signs will direct you as you turn onto Speedwell Lane.) All vehicles MUST be parked on the grass and NOT on the main road. Parking in the BLUE ZONE (see picture)

- All registers Weddington players and parents have signed a COVID-19 risk assessment carried out by the football club and the venue (these will be sent separately)
- Large spacious car park with ample room for all parking, however teams to be reminded to consider social distancing when parking.
- Venue has clear markings (one-way route) with COVID-19 signage reminding people of their responsibilities.
- Hand sanitiser will be available for everyone attending matches at the venue as will hand washing within the clubhouse (masks to be worn inside).
- Currently no hot food being served at the venue, however following local authority clearance, hot drinks are available.
- All spectators are expected to "bubble" in their own household groups and observe 2 metre social distancing behind the respect barrier (this will be further back than normal to allow for social distancing.
- Should we get a significant number of spectators, additional respect barriers are available for us to use to aid social distancing.
- Players must use hand sanitiser before during and after the game.
- All equipment will be sterilised before the match including match balls.
- Spectators and players must not arrive at the venue any earlier than 45 minutes prior to kick-off.
- No changing room facilities are available.
- NHS Track and Trace: visiting team officials are responsible for keeping a
 list of their own team's players and spectators in attendance. If an outbreak
 is reported, a Weddington Sports official directly contact the team manager
 of the away team, who can then contact his or her own players and family
 members, to adhere to government guidance. This reduces the need for
 multiple people to share a pen/clipboard and fill in their details.

- All venues are public sites so we cannot limit numbers on site and there is not a one way system
- For those involved in watching matches social distancing of 1 metre plus must be adhered to − 1 spectator per player.
- Players are not to arrive any earlier than 45 minutes before kick off
- Spectators will be expected to socially distance (minimum 1 metre) and spectators for the different teams will be allocated areas away from each area. Coloured cones will be used to identify where each teams spectators must stand (eg home team by red cones, away team by yellow cones), these will replace respect barriers in order to reduce touch points
- Each manager has appropriate PPE if close contact with a player is needed.
- There will be no toilet facilities available on site
- Each team will keep a record of players attending and who is accompanying them, however as all sites are public sites recording names of all people at the venue is not possible
- If a player or spectator reports a case of COVID, the manager will inform the CWO and COVID officer and arrangements will be made to inform all other parties that have possibly been affected.
- Following the conclusion of games all players and spectators will be required to leave immediately and not gather in groups except for a brief team review which will follow social distancing guidelines
- A risk assessment has been carried out for each venue and shared with the other stakeholders such as local councils and Ministry of Defence
