And this year we have started a burgeoning relationship with the Cargilfield School based Edinburgh Cricket Academy, which is managed by Scotland's foremost batsman today, George Munsey. In his spare time, George happens to be our Director of Cricket.



We currently have a vacancy for a scorer to work with our friendly and competitive 2nd XI, who ply their trade in the East of Scotland Division 2. They play 90% of their games on Saturday, 50% of which would be at our home ground in Barnton, NW Edinburgh with free secure parking and or serviced by the Lothian 21, 29, 41, 56 and X56 buses which all operate frequently. At The Royal High School, we have a traditional scoreboard for you to work from and a welcoming bar with Sky Sports and all the things you would expect of a sports club operating since 1861. For away games, lifts would be provided by our friendly team.



The season begins on 29th April and will run to 27th August. There are friendlies arranged for newcomers to learn on 22nd and 23rd April. We are totally flexible with the method of scoring you might wish to use, depending on your experience and interest. Previously, we have used traditional scorebook scoring, we have had scorers use linear scoring sheets and there is an opportunity to learn how to use a live scoring app on your tablet or phone if that interests you. In fact, given it is a fairly simple process you do not need experience, just an eye for detail and the desire to learn. The time commitment is circa noon to 7pm on matchdays and would suit anyone with a love for cricket to a complete newcomer, a retiree or anyone looking to make new friends.



Again, we will stress that should you have limited experience of scoring a game, we will be able to offer training and support. The art of scoring is about patience and concentration. The failsafe is there is always at least 9 people within ear shot who can help, at any point throughout the day.
