

Worthing County Local Committee

Community Initiative Funding Applications

- For the financial year 2009/10 Worthing CLC had a total of £54,139.80 to disburse. Of this, £43,726.12 has been allocated, leaving £10,986.18 for disbursement
- The following application was deferred from the previous meeting and is now being reconsidered for allocation:

Worthing Unified Bowls Tournament, £5,000.00, towards staging the annual bowls event

- The following applications have been received by the committee since the last meeting:

Circusseen, £2,500.00 towards room hire costs, equipment and outreach work.

Broadwater Cricket Club, £928.00 towards equipment costs for youth cricket in Broadwater

Northbrook Barn Community Centre, £3,556.00 towards modernisation of the kitchen.

Tarring Young People's Club, £3,000.00, pump-priming funds for volunteer expenses.

Science, Technology, English & Maths (STEM), £185.00, towards costs of bringing Brighton University project to Davison High School

Durrington Festival, £2,500.00, towards running costs for the annual festival.

Chippingdale Cricket Club, £5,000.00, contribution towards the construction of a two bay cricket net with security cage and an artificial match wicket.

Total amount applied for: £22,669.00

1. The County Councillors are recommended to approve the following applications and amounts

Circusseen £2,500.00

Durrington Festival, £2,500.00

Tarring Young People's Club, £3,000.00

STEM, £185.00

Northbrook Barn Community Centre, £2,801.18

2. The County Councillors are recommended to decline the following applications:

Worthing Unified Bowls Tournament - as falls outside of criteria
Chippingdale Cricket Club – as a substantial shortfall remains in the fundraising target it was deemed unlikely that funds could be spent within the required six-month window. Applicant is encouraged to re-apply when nearer the project's total cost.

3. The County Councillors are recommended to defer the following applications:

Broadwater Cricket Club – request for area-based membership breakdown of young members.
