Zone 10 got maintained their momentum, stretching the lead out to 16 shots by the mid-way point of the match when Zone 2 began to fight back.

By the 40th end Zone 2 had closed the gap to just 6 shots but by the 50th end Zone 10 had taken a stranglehold on the match, stretching the score to 60-40 on the 50th end.

Zone 2 closed the gap in the final stages, however Zone 10 did not relinquish control of the match and ran out winners by 71-53.
