CLUB ARRANGEMENTS FROM 22nd MAY 2021

From Saturday 22nd May, there will be no restrictions on when the green can be used after 11am each day.

All rinks will be open for play, including practice and coaching, using all formats.

BOOKINGS

We are reverting to our pre-pandemic booking system. If you would like to book a rink, please do so using the rink bookings folder which is kept in the pavilion, at the information desk. This will take effect from Saturday 22nd May. From this date, no further bookings will be made via the website.

All existing bookings made recently through Chris Robinson will be transferred to the bookings folder.

The weekday morning roll-ups will revert to previous arrangements, ie when you arrive you should write your name on the chalk board. A volunteer will need to arrange teams.

AT THE CLUB

Spectators are permitted to come to the club, a maximum of 30 spectators is allowed at any time. This number is in addition to those playing on the green.

Everyone coming onto the site must sign in and out and maintain social distancing rules at all times.

The changing rooms will be open for access to toilets and lockers. Please ensure no more than two people are in the changing room at any time. Please be mindful of other members waiting to access lockers and keep your time in the changing room to a minimum, changing shoes outside if possible. Please disinfect all surfaces touched after use (disinfectant wipes will be provided).

You should wear a facemask when you are moving around inside the pavilion.

HOSPITALITY

The kitchen will remain closed to members. However, refreshments will be served to players after S&DWBA matches, and the bar will be open during S&D matches. Teams may sit indoors, in groups of 6.

BOWLING GUIDELINES FROM 22nd MAY

- When you arrive, you **MUST** sign in, load the Track and Trace QR code (on the pavilion door) into your mobile phone if you have one.
- Please try not to crowd the verandah – use the benches on the sides of the green to change shoes etc.
- All equipment can now be used, including scoreboards and spray chalk. Equipment should be retrieved from the pre-lockdown storage places (the two end cupboards on the verandah – the code to open these is the same as for the club gate). Sanitise and set out equipment before play.
- Agree who will move jacks, mats and pushers, in order to minimise touching these. Each lead player should have their own jack (white/yellow for each rink)
- At the end of the game, sanitise and return the equipment to the normal storage place. Dispose of all paper towels in the general rubbish bin, or take them home.
- Sign out before you leave the site. If you are the last to leave, ensure that the pavilion alarm is set and the site is secure.
- **Please remember that social distancing (2m) is still necessary! Practise strict hand hygiene whenever you have been sharing equipment.**
