- IB Diploma candidates only
- Course runs Sept - March for 0.75 credits

## II. IB T.O.K with Civics

- During the school day
- IB Diploma candidates MAY select if there are no other conflicts
- Course runs full school year (1.0 credit) and includes Senior Social Studies Civics requirement
- Any Senior is eligible to take IB TOK with Civics to meet their Senior Social Studies requirements.

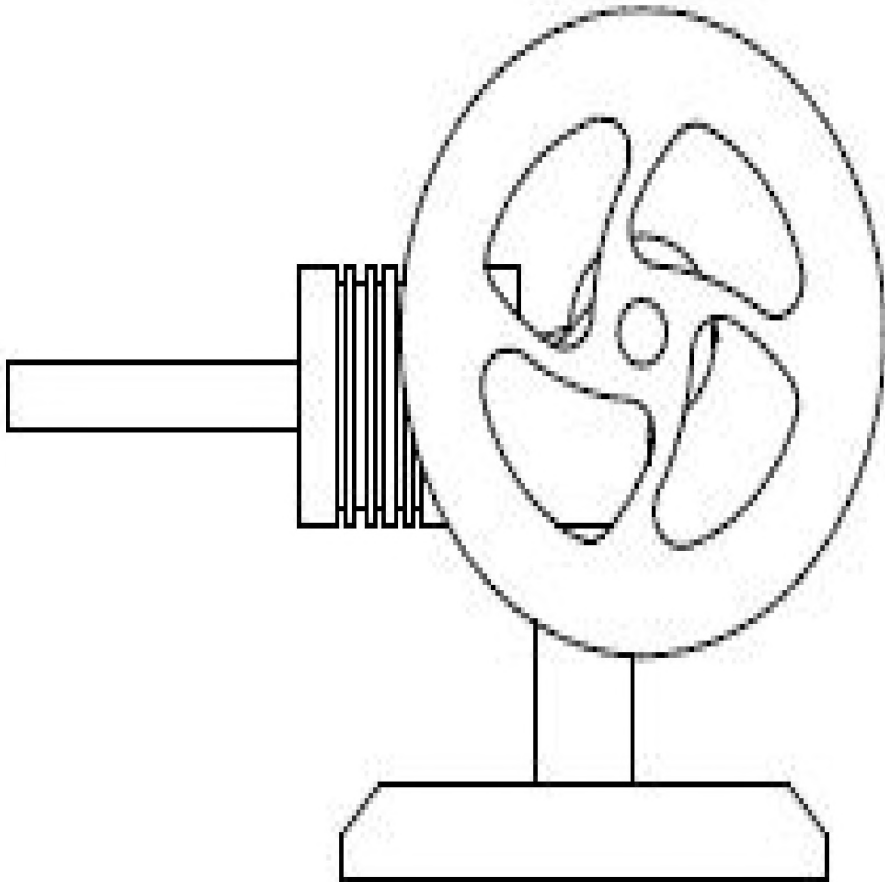

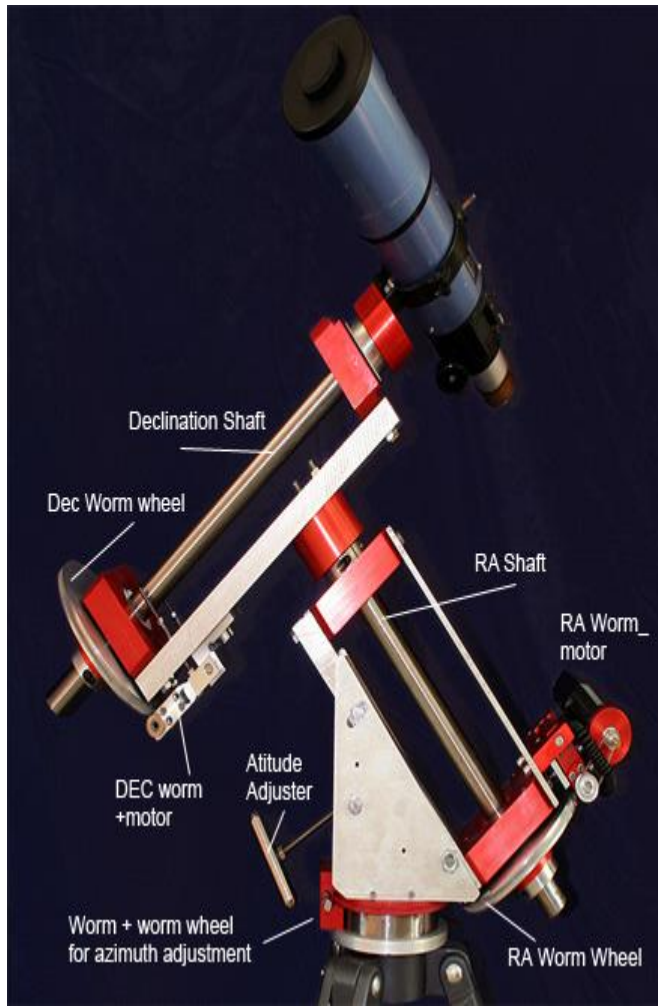
