JUNIOR CRICKET

St Ives & Warboys Cricket Club has an amazing junior section with training and matches for Under 9s, U11s, U13s & U15s operating across both sites in St Ives & Warboys.

We also run ECB All Stars for ages 5 to 8 from our site in Warboys.

All our coaches are fully qualified and we are proud to boast some of the best facilities and training aids available to help develop our juniors skills.

Our charging structure is very competitively priced to include all training sessions and we have club equipment including bats, pads, gloves and helmets that can be used free of charge.





AGE GROUPS

ALL STARS - AGES 5-8 SCHOOL YEARS

All Stars Cricket provides a fantastic first experience for all children aged 5-8 years old where they're guaranteed 8 weeks of jam-packed fun, activity and skills development.

The programme is designed to introduce children to the sport, teaching them new skills, helping them make new friends and have a great time doing so.

U9S - SCHOOL YEARS 3 AND 4.

The team plays in the Hunts County U9 8 a-side league At this age, plastic 'incrediballs' are used rather than proper cricket balls and therefore players do not need to wear pads, helmets etc. However, in matches gloves and a box are required when batting or wicket keeping. The training is all about developing the basic skills required to play cricket.

U11S - SCHOOL YEARS 5 AND 6

The team plays in both 11 a-side and 8 a-side Hunts County League. At this age, real 4 % ounce cricket balls are used, so helmets, batting pads, gloves etc need to be used.

U13 - SCHOOL YEARS 7 AND 8

The team plays in the Hunts County U13 11 a-side league.

At this age, $4\,\%$ ounce cricket balls are used and therefore helmets, batting pads, gloves etc must be used.

U15 - SCHOOL YEARS 9 AND 10

The team plays in the Hunts County U15 League. At this age, full size 5 ½ ounce cricket balls are used so helmets, batting pads, gloves etc must be worn.

SHAUN ASPLIN - Coach Development Officer Level 2A Club Coach and been coaching for over 13 years and 11 years with the County Age Groups I am also the Beds & Hunts Coaches Association Chairman supporting coaches across the two counties and have been lead coach to the Hunts County boys U13's and U17's, Hunts County Girls U15's and currently the Cricket East combined Beds and Hunts U18 boys assistant coach.

My coaching philosophy is to create an environment that the players learn to understand themselves and their game, self-develop with the right level of challenge and support by working hard but still having fun.

"I am a Level 2 children's cricket coach, trained in safeguarding, DBS checked, a qualified first aider and recently Level 2 qualified in understanding children's mental health.. I am also a Lead County Coach having led U11s for the past 2 Years.

All my sessions are around being fun, interactive and are delivered in a way that is player centric which means that each player receives personalised coaching within a group setting.

Like many parents I began coaching when my own children started playing cricket and even though they have now left home and play elsewhere, i still love to help out and find it very rewarding.

My most rewarding part of coaching is seeing our young players in matches and putting into practice what they have learnt at our training


