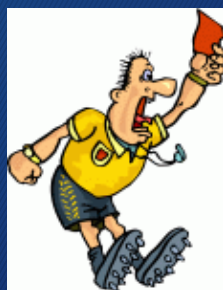
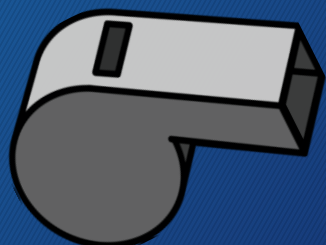

Congratulations to all those who have taken a coaching course this past year!

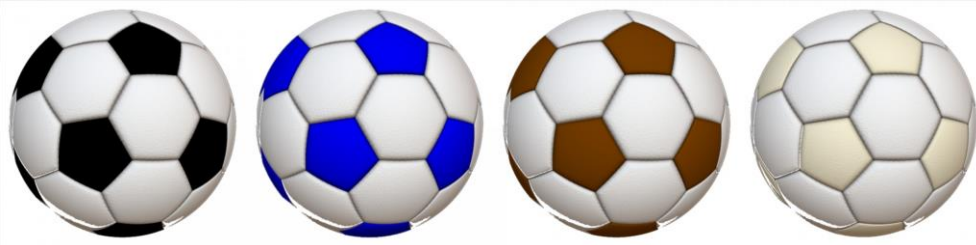
In 2019 OSA has:
