Visit to Fotheringhay

Thursday 21 July

A unique opportunity to visit the village of Fotheringhay, a few miles south-west of Peterborough.

Fotheringhay Castle was where Mary Queen of Scots was last held captive, was tried and executed in 1587.

We will make our own way there, meeting at 11am at the church - postcode PE8 5HZ. Approximately 75-minute drive from Letchworth. Road-side parking alongside the church.

We start with a talk by local resident Colin Pendrill, former Head of History at Oundle School, about the Castle, and the events involving Mary. We then walk the short way to where the castle stood, followed by a short explanation of the site by Colin, and free time to explore.

After a sandwich lunch in the church, Colin will tell us about its history, then lead us on a short guided tour of the significant features.

There is a charge of £12 per person to cover the cost of lunch and a donation to the church; the donation being at Colin's request, as he will not charge for the talk.

This visit is arranged by the Opera and Ballet Group. It follows their 5 July meeting, watching the significant parts of Donizetti's opera *Maria Stuarda* (see page 10).
