GROUND REGULATIONS

These Ground Regulations shall apply to each Match taking place at the Ground. Entry to the Ground shall constitute acceptance of these Ground Regulations and the Rules and Regulations. These Ground Regulations incorporate the Club's Customer Charter (if any).

Definitions: "Club" means this football club. "Football Authorities" means the Football League, the Premier League, The Football Association, the Football Association of Wales, the league of which the Club is in membership from time to time, FIFA, UEFA and any other relevant governing body of association football. "Ground" means this football stadium and all locations owned, occupied or utilised by the Club. "Ground Regulations" means these ground regulations, as amended from time to time. "Match" means any association football match (or any part or aspect of such a match) taking place at the Ground. "Material" means any audio, digital, visual or audio-visual material or any information or data. "Rules and Regulations" means each of the rules and regulations of the Football Authorities that may be relevant to the Club, the Club and/or the Ground from time to time.

1. Entry to the Ground shall constitute acceptance of these Ground Regulations and the Rules and Regulations. All persons entering the Ground must have paid the relevant admission fee to the Football Spectators Act 1989 (as amended); charge. Proof of age, where an age concession is claimed, and proof of identity may be required. 1.1 Attempting to enter the Ground or being inside the Ground whilst drunk; quired and must be supplied on demand.

4. The Club excludes, to the maximum extent permitted by law, any liability for loss, injury or damage to persons and property in or around the Ground. Nothing in this Ground Regula- 18. CHADDERTON FC V CHARNOCK RICHARD FC

23 SEPTEMBER 2023

OUR VISITORS: CHARNOCK RICHARD FC

CHARNOCK RICHARD F.C. HAS A STORIED HISTORY, ORIGINATING IN THE CHORLEY SUNDAY LEAGUE IN 1933. DURING WWII, BOTH THE LEAGUE AND TEAM WERE PUT ON HOLD. AFTER THE WAR, IN 1945, THEY WERE REFORMED, ACHIEVING NOTABLE SUCCESS, INCLUDING WINNING THE LEAGUE TITLE IN THE 1947-48 SEASON.

HOWEVER, IN THE 1948-49 SEASON, THE CLUB FACED DIFFICULTIES WHEN ATTEMPTING TO RUN TWO TEAMS AND SUBSEQUENTLY CLOSED. IN 1955, THE CLUB WAS REVIVED UNDER RON WILCOX'S LEADERSHIP AND REJOINED THE CHORLEY ALLIANCE LEAGUE. IN 1957, THEY MOVED TO THE PRESTON & DISTRICT LEAGUE, WITH SUCCESSFUL CAMPAIGNS AND HONORS, NOTABLY THE GUILDHALL CUP.

THE 1967-68 SEASON BROUGHT VICTORY IN THE LANCASHIRE AMATEUR SHIELD, AND MORE SUCCESSSES FOLLOWED IN SUBSEQUENT SHIELD COMPETITIONS. IN 1993, THE CLUB MOVED TO THE WEST LANCASHIRE LEAGUE, WITH BOTH FIRST AND SECOND TEAMS EARNING PROMOTIONS. THEY ACHIEVED CONSIDERABLE SUCCESS, INCLUDING MULTIPLE PREMIER DIVISION CHAMPIONSHIPS. IN 2016-17, CHARNOK RICHARD JOINED THE NORTH WEST COUNTIES LEAGUE, SECURING PROMOTION TO THE PREMIER DIVISION IN THEIR INAUGURAL SEASON. THE CLUB CONSISTENTLY PERFORMED WELL, FINISHING IN THE TOP SIX OF THE DIVISION. IN THE 2021/22 SEASON, THEY FINISHED FOURTH AND CLINCHED THEIR FIRST NWCFL MACRON LEAGUE CUP AT CHORLEY FC'S VICTORY PARK, TRIUMPHING 5-0 AGAINST CAMELL LAIRD.

OVER THE YEARS, THE CLUB EXPANDED TO INCLUDE JUNIOR TEAMS IN LEAGUES LIKE THE MID LANCS COLTS JUNIOR FOOTBALL LEAGUE AND THE CENTRAL LANCASHIRE JUNIOR FOOTBALL LEAGUE, ALONGSIDE A YOUTH TEAM IN THE LANCASHIRE SUNDAY FOOTBALL LEAGUE.

THE CLUB'S HOME BASE, MOSSIE CLOSE IN CHARTER LANE, UNDERWENT DEVELOPMENT, WITH A NEW GROUND, MOSSIE PARK, ESTABLISHED ON THE OPPOSITE SIDE OF CHARTER LANE. THIS GROUND NOW HOSTS NORTH WEST COUNTIES LEAGUE AND WEST LANCASHIRE LEAGUE MATCHES, WITH MODERN CHANGING ROOMS INAUGURATED IN JULY 2011. THIS SUMMARY ENCAPSULATES THE KEY MILESTONES AND ACHIEVEMENTS OF CHARNOK RICHARD F.C. FROM ITS INCEPTION IN THE 1930S TO ITS RECENT SUCCESSSES IN THE NORTH WEST COUNTIES LEAGUE.
