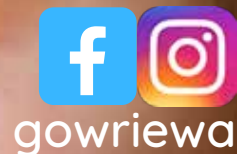

# Chase of the Lions begins

**For the past five seasons Subiaco has set the trend in the home-and-away rounds.**

And it took two AFL-talent laden Peel Thunder teams to deny them two premierships in that period.

This weekend the Lions will advance to a sixth consecutive grand final if they can win the Second Semi-Final.

But can South Fremantle stop the Subiaco run? Could a West Coast Eagles team use the First Semi-Final to lay its claim to a berth in the premiership decider.

The WAFL competition is down to four teams and the Football Budget looks at the big games that will determine which of them continues towards the biggest game of the year and which heads into planning for 2020.

## SECOND SEMI-FINAL

**SUBIACO v SOUTH FREMANTLE**  
Sunday September 8, 2.10pm,  
Leederville Oval.

Only one team has been able to stop Subiaco in the past two WAFL season.

Fortunately, for the Lions' opponents in this final it was South Fremantle.

And it was achieved at the same ground as this week's contest.

So, what went so right for the Bulldogs that they were able to notch a 22-point win in Round 6?

Without a doubt it was the efforts of some of South Fremantle's lesser lights that enabled Todd Curley's men to achieve a rare WAFL feat in recent times.

Jake Florenca, Noah Strom, Kyle Russell and Zac Dent will again have to rise to the occasion to help the Bulldogs pull off another upset win.

It is expected that Haiden Schloithe, ruckman Brock Higgins and Nic Suban will lead the South Fremantle charge. They were certainly important to the Bulldogs' victory over Claremont in the Qualifying Final last week.

But Florenca showed with his 27 possessions against the Lions in May that he, too, can have an impact on his team's performance.

Strom was not only a block in defence but his solid ball use helped South Fremantle rebound. And Kyle Russell bobbed up to kick three goals. Aiming to produce more than 12 goals will be critical to the visitors' quest for success.

However, it has to be remembered that Subiaco did reverse the result in Round 11. But then it would be pointless to concentrate on that one fixture when Beau Wardman's team has had so many other dominant performances in 2019.

Keeping Lachlan Delahunty under control will be critical to the Bulldogs' game plan and Curley might consider using Strom as a run-with player to curb the influence of the Lions ruckman.

Yet just as a coach plugs one hole, another problem can pop up.

With Kyal Horsley, Leigh Kitchin and Max Walters in the middle Subiaco has plenty of grunt to kick-start their best attacking moves. It was also significant that defender Angus

Litherland was a key to the Lions' win over the Bulldogs in June.

## FIRST SEMI-FINAL

**CLAREMONT v WEST COAST EAGLES**  
Sunday September 8, 2.10pm,  
Revo Fitness Stadium.

If their first round finals were any indication it would be folly to think either Claremont or West Coast Eagles can't fight out a WAFL battle until the death.

The Tigers might be ruing the loss to South Fremantle in the Qualifying Final but if there were five minutes more in the encounter there was a distinct possibility the loss could have been reversed.

And despite resting a few AFL-listed players in the dying stages of their do-or-die Elimination Final against West Perth, the Eagles found enough reserves to produce a match-winning goal with about 90 seconds to play.

It means whoever is to triumph from this sudden-death encounter will need to get on top early – and extend the advantage as the game progresses.

The one element Claremont will also have to overcome is the size of the West Coast team.

Just because of the nature of the AFL-listed talent available, the Eagles are tall. Yet, even in wet and windy conditions, the high-sized players adapted to dominate most of the first-round final.

Keegan Brooksby (198cm), Bailey Williams (199cm), Fraser McInnes (198cm), Drew Petrie (197cm), Nathan Vardy 200cm) and Harry Edwards (197cm) will stretch any WAFL team's resources.

The pairing of Brayden Ainsworth and Hamish Brayshaw can give West Coast some bite if the tall timber can bring the ball to ground level.

But Claremont's strength is its midfield. With Jye Bolton, Kane Mitchell and Declan Mountford, who was instrumental in getting the Tigers back in the contest with the Bulldogs, the home team has plenty of key weapons.

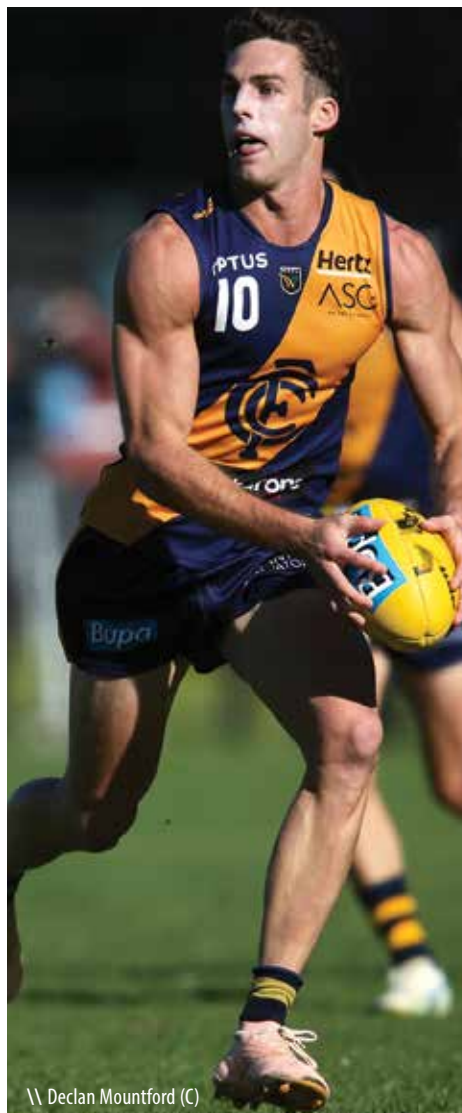
If Tom Lee is available to return to the forward line it will enable Anton Hamp to go back to defence and help keep some of the Eagles' scoring potential under check.

Claremont coach Darren Harris might persist with playing defender Haydn Busher on a wing to add to the Tigers' strength in congestion.

# Collectables

**During 2019, the Football Budget will again feature a section on WAFL memorabilia and invites you to write or email if you want more information about the football collectables you have tucked away at home.**

Football club lockers have appeared on these pages a few times over the past couple of years, most notably the Claremont lockers that have been sold at the club's last three gala auctions.

These were the lockers used by the players over many years, and the first lot of 10 each sold for between \$200 and \$400, back in 2017.

Another 11 sold last year for between \$100 and \$320 each.

The Tigers' lockers are all gone now, the last lot having been sold at the club's recent gala event.

But I'm reliably informed that East Perth is considering selling off its old lockers, which were recently replaced.

And West Perth has now started selling off its locker doors. Yep, just the doors. Unfortunately, the bodies were disposed of when they were removed from underneath the grandstand at Joondalup.

The plan had been to reuse the doors as decoration in the club's new facilities, but that plan has been abandoned and three doors were sold off at the club's auction last week.

The door for Number 13, featuring the names of players like Tom Soutar, Murray Leeder and Brendan Barrows, sold for \$500, while the door for Number 21, which was worn by Wally Price and Brian Foley, fetched \$575.

And the Number 25 door, bearing the names of Brian France, Geoff Hendriks and Ray Bartholomew, sold for \$675.

Keep an eye out for more of the Falcons' locker doors in future auctions.

It's quite amazing how many pieces of WAFL memorabilia were produced by the oil companies.

As regular readers of this column would know, most of those were cards and stickers/decals.

But the other one-off area of memorabilia that Caltex tried out, sometime around 1970, was a cloth patch.

I've featured in this column many times the various cloth patches produced by the Daily News in 1960, 1962, 1963, 1965 and 1966/67.



But Caltex's eight club patches are just as attractive to collectors.

Sadly, I had only ever seen three of them, until this week when Greg turned up a Subiaco patch he had stuffed into a scrapbook many years ago.

Greg couldn't remember how he got it, having had it since he was a kid. He also couldn't explain why, as a Swans supporter, he had a Maroons patch.

I have the Swans and West Perth patches in my own collection and received a photograph of the Perth patch some years ago.

So, as always, I'm hoping to see the East Fremantle, South Fremantle, Claremont and East Perth patches, if any readers can help?

I finished last week's WAFL Collectables with a question for readers, which was borne from the discovery of an advertisement published in a football publication during the 1920s.

The ad was for the "Westralia" football, which was made in WA and promised to keep its shape better than any of its competitors, Burley included.

The Westralia was made by Hugo Fischer Pty Ltd, of Perth and Geraldton.

I also promised to investigate further, if nobody was able to provide any information about the company.

And that's what I've managed to do this week.

It turns out that the Westralia brand was trademarked in 1923 but had been in production for at least a year before that.

Hugo Fischer Ltd was formed

in Perth in 1910, so we know that Burley (formed in 1907) is still the oldest football manufactured in Western Australia.

And both Hugo Fischer Ltd's "Westralia" and Burley's "Western" were sold through department stores, including Foys, along with the Ross Faulkner ball that came from the East.

Fischer also produced a slightly lesser quality football, called the Crownall, from at least as early as 1924 and was producing a ball called the "Gawler" for the South Australian market by 1925.

But the business was entirely West Australian, with tanning yards at North Fremantle and a factory in Perth that required 400 to 500 hides each year for the production of its footballs. The balls were hand-stitched, using a fine flax.

Sadly, the Westralia may have been a victim of the Great Depression, with the last record of the ball with the "flying boot" logo coming in a newspaper ad published in 1933.

Hugo Fischer Ltd, however, did continue much later. The company, which was named after its owner (who was from a family of Jewish saddlers that traded under the name E Fischer & Sons Ltd, of Adelaide) made equipment for the AIF during WWII, and even made John Curtin's briefcase.

It was still going in the 1980s, manufacturing pool covers.

I would love to see a Westralia football, if there are any still in existence.

Last, but not least for this week, I visited the From Redlegs to Demons History Centre at Lathlain a few weeks back and noticed a great little Demons pennant that I hadn't seen before.

The pennant was made of some fairly heavy vinyl and appeared to date to the 1980s. I would be interested to know if these were produced for any of the other clubs.

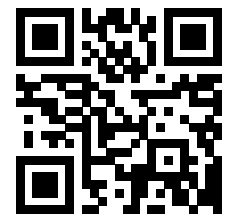

## Research highlights footy's economic injection

**The West Australian Football Commission has revealed the most comprehensive study ever into the economic and social benefits of local football to the WA community.**

Completed by ACIL Allen, the report assesses the social and economic impact of club-based football in WA and provides a measurement tool that will enable the WAFC to track social impact on an annual basis.

In an industry-first, the report uses club-based participation as the key metric to quantify the social returns of the entire industry, which identifies that the broad range of community benefits from WA football include:

**Every dollar spent by club-based football in WA creates two dollars of economic activity.**

- WA footy generates over \$220 million in economic benefits to WA.
- \$110 million is spent directly, including almost \$16 million on supplies and services.

**For every person employed by football directly, another job is created in the community.**

- In total, the equivalent of more than 1,400 full time jobs are generated by football across WA.
- With the people employed by football directly also spending their money locally, the jobs created by football extend even further.
- This creates jobs in industries as diverse as health, catering, cleaning, photography and grounds management.

**Club-based footy generates an additional \$225 million in social benefits each year.**

- The research shows that being part of a footy club provides participants with the equivalent of \$3,000 worth of social benefits in areas such as mental and physical health and personal well-being.
- Football is a sport that connects communities like no other, with 22 players and their families and friends interacting as part of the same team each week.
- Participants are physically active for almost three hours per week each year – even more than the 150 minutes recommended by the Heart Foundation.

WAFC chief executive Gavin Taylor said that being part of a footy club was about more than the game each weekend.

"We've always known the benefits of footy go beyond being a great game to play and watch. Now we have the research and findings to confirm this," he said.

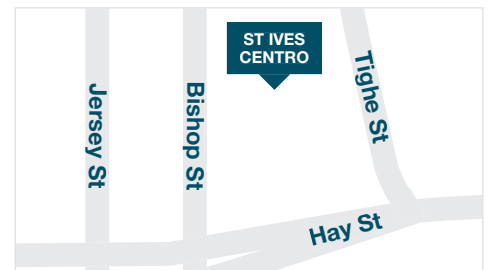
