Wolstanton Bowling Club is open to members of all ages and both sexes. Members enjoy the facilities of the club house which includes a licensed bar, a snooker room with two tables, a lounge overlooking the bowling green, a crown bowling green, pleasant paths, flower beds and seating around the green. There is also a kitchen where meals can be prepared for special occasions.

Through the year the club competes in the local bowling league and runs internal competitions for billiards, snooker and bowling.

The facilities of the club have improved massively over the last ten years (with further developments during 2011), often as a result of grant aid from local and national bodies. The club house is now completely double glazed and well insulated, and in the last year a new irrigation system has been installed to ensure the green is kept in good condition.

With many of our members being elderly we have provided easy access for the disabled.

After a certain period of membership, with the approval of the committee, members can elect to have a set of keys to the club and use it when they wish.

The club house is also available for special occasions such as wedding receptions, funerals, parties, etc. No fee is charged to members, but most make a donation towards costs incurred.

We also have "open days" when anyone can visit the club and play snooker or bowls without charge. Free refreshments are available.

We allow access to the grounds for residents of local care homes, on occasions when they may wish to bring disabled people to watch the bowls or just enjoy sitting out in the garden.

Each year we hold a Christmas party to which members of other local clubs are often invited, plus friends and relatives of members.



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


