Following the success of previous years, we are again running a 24 team format. The tournament begins with the 24 teams being divided randomly into four groups of six teams. Teams that reached the quarter final stage last year and entered again this year have been seeded into separate groups. Clubs, who have sent more than one team, have also been separated with the remaining teams randomly dropped into the last places.

Each team will play each other team in their group once, in a six minutes each way match to form the final tables.

The top **two** from each group will then go forward to the quarter final knock out stage in the main event, whilst the teams finishing **third** and **fourth** will go into the quarter finals of the plate tournament.

Groups will play on either pitch 1, 2 or 3. Please check timetable for times of matches and what pitches you are playing on. Please DON'T be late for your matches.

In order to keep us up to date, please can you ensure you bring your results over to us as soon as possible after your match. The responsibility for this lies with the match winners, or the 'home' team in the event of a draw.

CBFC Tournament Rules

Group Stages

1. The tournament begins with teams divided randomly into four groups of six teams.
2. Teams that reached the quarter final stage last year and entered again this year have been seeded into separate groups.
3. Clubs, who have sent more than one team, have also been separated with the remaining teams randomly dropped into the last places.
4. Each team will play each other team in their group once in six minute each way matches.
5. Match winners will receive 3 points. In matches that are drawn, both teams will receive 1 point each.
6. Groups will be decided by the following methods in order:
 - a. Points
 - b. In the event that teams are tied on points, goal difference shall decide the order.
 - c. In the event that teams are still tied, the result of the match between the teams concerned shall determine the order.
 - d. In the event that teams are still tied, a play off may be played to determine the final order. This match, if played, will be decided by a golden goal.

Knockout stages

1. The top two from each group will then go forward to the quarter final knock out stage in the main event.
2. The teams finishing third and fourth will go into the quarter finals of the plate tournament.
3. Quarter finals will be 6 minutes each way, followed by sudden death penalties to decide the winners where necessary.
4. Semi finals will be 8 minutes each way, followed by sudden death penalties to decide the winners where necessary.
5. Finals will be 8 minutes each way, followed by 4 minutes each way extra time. The first team to score during this time will be the winners. If the match is still drawn after this stage, each team will shoot four penalties, followed by sudden death penalties to determine the winner.

Tournament Management

1. Matches shall be run by qualified FA referees, their decisions shall be final.
2. For all other matters, any three members of the tournament committee that are brought together for a decision shall constitute a quorum whose decision shall be final.

Match Play

1. Normal Football Association Dress code rules for kit and footwear apply.
2. No outfield player may enter the area at any time. An opposing player entering the area shall result in a free kick away. Any players stepping into their own area will result in a penalty away.
3. Goalkeepers must not leave the area, if they do this will result in a free kick away.
4. Goal keepers may throw or kick the ball into play.
5. Throw-ins, corners and other set pieces follow normal football association rules.
6. There is no off side.
7. The tournament is registered and affiliated to the Football Association as an official Football Association tournament, therefore, all bookings will be reported to the League.

General

1. Teams can consist of from 6-9 players, with a maximum of 9 being able to play in one match.
2. Teams must be fully registered at the start of the tournament and before play commences.
3. Once the tournament starts, players may not swap teams - even between an A, B & C side from the same club. (Any players found guilty of swapping teams throughout the tournament, or if your team is knocked out, playing for another team, will be banned and any points from that match will be forfeited)
4. No Alcoholic drinks are to be consumed around the pitches/ground only in the designated area by the Clubhouse. This is a local council byelaw and is unbending.
