## THE HISTORY OF BROADFIELDS UNITED

**1993:** The Club was formed.

**1994/1995:** We ran ten teams, eight in the Southern Olympian League on Saturdays, five of those teams won their leagues with two teams finishing as runners-up.

**1995/1996:** Broadfields 1st team won the Presidents Cup at Harrow Borough.

**1996/1997:** They then went on to win Division One by six points, thus winning promotion to the Premier League.

**1998/1999:** Broadfields United Reserves came runners-up in Division One.

**2001/2002:** Broadfields ran six teams, 1st and Reserves playing in the Middlesex County Football League, Premier and Division One (Saturday's). Two teams played in the Harrow Sunday Challenge League and one played in the Hillingdon & District Sunday Football League. This was also the season of Broadfields Social Clubs disaster. We burnt to the ground, leaving only the changing/shower facilities. This however did not stop us from playing football, as indeed we did.

**2003/2004:** Broadfields runs less teams, 1st playing in the Middlesex County Football League, Premier Division, Manager: Marvin Hall, Coach: Mike Jennings, Physiotherapy: Mick Croft. Our Vets team played in the London Commercial League, Division 6 and went through to a cup Final. We also had two Sunday teams playing in the Harrow Sunday Challenge League. Chris Webster's team won the Harrow Sunday Challenge League Cup.

**2005/2006:** Chris Webster's team won the Harrow Sunday Challenge League and Jack Walker Cup.

**2006/2007:** Chris Webster's team won the Harrow Sunday Challenge League and Benevolent Shield.

**2007/2008:** Chris Webster's team were runners up in both the Sunday Premier Cup and Champions Cup.

**2008/2009:** Chris Webster's team won the Champions Cup and Jack Walker Challenge Cup. They were runners up in the Premier League.

**2009/2010:** Dene Gardner's (Saturday) team were runners up in the Middlesex Intermediate Cup. Chris Webster's team won the Middlesex County Premier Cup and Champions Cup. They were runners up in the League and the Harrow Premier Cup.

**2010/2011:** A disappointing season by Broadfields standard. The Sunday team came runners up in the Champions Cup Final, narrowly losing 2-1.

**2011/12:** Alec Smith Premier Cup Champions. Chris Webster and Ryan Duffy lead the Saturday team to their first bit of silverware in many years.

**2012/13:** Alec Smith Premier Cup Champions. Ryan Duffy and Chris Webster defended their title whilst the newly reformed reserves under the management of David Webster and Robbie Pearce who lost in the Junior Open Cup Final and came runners up in the league. A successful season for the club.

**2013/14:** David Webster and Robbie Pearce proved very successful with the reserves by winning the Middlesex Senior Reserve Division and the Junior Open Cup.

## THE HISTORY OF BROADFIELDS UNITED...(CONT)

**2014/15** : A terrific end to the season saw Ryan Duffy and Chris Webster lead their side to promotion to the Spartan South Midlands League Division One. The side lost just one of their final ten games and were granted promotion on the final day. The second side, led by David Webster and Robbie Pearce, moved their team to the Hertfordshire County League Division One and managed a mid-table finish and were unlucky to not make a final, being knocked out at the semi-final stage twice.

**2015/16** : The club's first season in Spartan South Midlands League football saw us achieve an 11th place finish. The side also reached the semi-final of the Division One Cup. The Sunday Side completed a quadruple, winning the Harrow Sunday Challenge Premier Division, the Premier Cup, the Champions Cup and the Jack Walker Cup.

**2016/17** : The First team, under the guidance of Mark Barnham, Liam Bird & Ryan Duffy, won the Middlesex Premier Cup by defeating Hillingdon Borough 4-1 at Northwood FC's ground. They also reached the second-round proper of the FA Vase. The Reserve side managed by Dean Foster, won promotion to the Herts Senior County League.

**2017/18** : The First team, under the guidance of Liam Bird, Mark Barnham & Ryan Duffy, successfully defended the Middlesex Premier Cup by defeating landlords, Harefield 1-0 at Harrow Borough FC. Success continued 5 days later when they triumphed in the Spartan League Challenge Trophy cup final when they beat Risborough Rangers in the final 3-1. Finally, first time in the club's history, we booked a place in the FA Cup for the forthcoming season after finishing 4th in the league. The Reserve side managed by Dean Foster also reached the Anagrams Record Trophy Final but went down 2-0 to Catholic United from the Essex League.

**2018/19** : The end of the 2018/19 season saw the first team achieve their main aim as promotion was secured. A tally of 94 points saw us finish behind runaway leaders, Harefield United, but guaranteed us a place as one of the top 9 teams from the 19 leagues at Step 6 and thus achieving promotion to Step 5 for the very first time. It was a long season which saw us play in our first ever FA Cup game, beating Banstead Athletic 3-0 in a memorable Extra Preliminary round tie. Unfortunately, in the next round we went down 4-1 to AFC Uckfield Town but nonetheless it was a great experience for the club to appear in the oldest cup competition in the world.

It wasn't to be quite as memorable for the reserve side who struggled in the league and although they managed to stay up on the last day of the season, the tough decision to withdraw the side in the close season was made.

**2019/20** : The season started full of optimism with the club playing Step 5 football for the first time and although the season started off brightly the team found the step up in opposition quality hard to deal with at times. We managed to find our feet and began picking up some good results along the way before COVID-19 curtailed the season. The highlight of the season was unquestionably a 2-1 victory away at Conference South side, Hampton and Richmond to reach the Semi-Final of the Middlesex Senior Cup in our first season in the competition. Although we were defeated in the next round away at Bedfont Sports.

**2020/21**: Ahead of the new season the club secured a new groundshare with Rayners Lane FC, a move back closer to the club's traditional 'home' of Harrow. Sadly, it meant departing Harefield United's Preston Park after many successful seasons.

# RAMBLING RANGER

Well, we are now two games in to the new season and it has been an exciting start to the Clubs first ever foray at Step 5 of the FA Pyramid. First up was a difficult trip to one of the fancied sides in the Spartan South Midlands League Premier Division, Leighton Town and following an excellent game of football in front of a partisan 300 plus crowd (it's so good to have crowds back) we had to be content to share the spoils in a one all draw, Rangers' goal scored by Sean Coles. Next up was FA Cup action and we had the advantage of a home draw against Gloucestershire side, Lydney Town. Thanks to that man Coles again, who scored a spectacular late winner, we go through to the next round where we are again at home, this time versus Ascot United.

Before the Covid madness took over our lives and interrupted the important business of football I had made several references in this column to the previous tenants of the BEP Stadium, Princes Risborough Town FC and I promised to do a little research into the now defunct club. Thanks to the help of several older residents of the area and a very handy book on the Hellenic League borrowed from Rob Cairney I have been able to piece together a short history:

## *Part 1*

### *1891-1963*

It is referenced in one publication that Princes Risborough Town FC were founded in 1891. I cannot confirm this however and it has been suggested by some of my sources that the Town club came into being shortly after WW11 following the amalgamation of several local clubs, including Parkfield Rovers and Princes Risborough FC. Early games were played on the outfield of the Windsor Playing Field cricket ground before the pitch was laid and dressing rooms built next door where the BEP Stadium now stands. Members of the Berks & Bucks FA, they competed in the Princes Risborough & District League which included several other clubs from the Risborough area during a time when there were more pubs in town than shops! They were champions of the Princes Risborough & District League in the 1950-51 season and completed the double at the end of the season by winning the League's cup competition. The following season was spent in the Aylesbury & District League before the Club joined the Oxfordshire Senior League for the 1952-53 season. The Club were losing finalists in the Oxfordshire Senior League Cup Final in their only season in the league. The following season saw the Club begin a 21year membership of the newly formed Hellenic Football League as founder members.

In 1952 a meeting at the Pressed Steel Sports & Social Club in Oxford was organised by referee, Mr Norman Matthews, to discuss the proposal of a new senior league to cover the Oxon, Berks & Bucks area in the hope of creating a higher calibre of football. In the event, not only did representatives from ambitious clubs in those three counties attend, including Princes Risborough Town, but clubs from six other counties arrived (Gloucestershire, Middlesex, Herefordshire, Northants, Bedfordshire and Wiltshire) eager to be part of the new league. A unanimous vote agreed to set up a new league to bridge the geographical area stretching between the Western League and the many London leagues. It was decided to call the new league 'The Coronation League' to mark the new Queen's Coronation. Approval was finally given by the FA with the proviso that they could not use the name Coronation. At a further meeting it was decided that, in line with many of the leagues of that time, that they would use the name of a Greek or Roman God. The name 'Hellenic Football League' was chosen and later approved by the FA. The chairman of the new league was Professor George W Keeton, also chairman of Princes Risborough Town FC.

## RAMBLING RANGER *(continued)*

It was decided to call the new league 'The Coronation League' to mark the new Queen's Coronation. Approval was finally given by the FA with the proviso that they could not use the name Coronation. At a further meeting it was decided that, in line with many of the leagues of that time, that they would use the name of a Greek or Roman God. The name 'Hellenic Football League' was chosen and later approved by the FA. The chairman of the new league was Professor George W Keeton, also chairman of Princes Risborough Town FC.

1953-54, Town's first season in the new league was a disastrous one, finishing bottom out of 16 and losing all of their 30 fixtures. They did manage to score 33 but at the other end of the pitch their opponents amassed 160 goals. A slight improvement the following season saw Leighton United pip Town for the bottom spot with Risborough finishing 18th from 19. 1955/56 saw them back in the bottom spot having won only four from their 34 matches. The following season, with more clubs looking to join the, saw the creation of a Division One with the top division now named the Premier Division. In what appears an act of kindness Town were placed in the newly formed second tier. The 'climate' certainly suited them better as they managed a fourth place out of 10 teams, with top scorer Alan Vickers scoring 13. There followed a period of mid table mediocrity for a few seasons, highlights being the 58/59 season where they reached the final of the Division One Cup, losing to Thatcham, and gaining fourth place in the table. Jonny Rogers top scored with 21.
