On behalf of everyone connected with Rotherham Hockey Club, from committee, players and volunteers, we would like to welcome you all to our celebratory events in commemoration of the grand unveiling of our new pitch here in Rotherham. The programme of events, over four days are a celebration not only to our new facilities but also to our late President, Eric Duke and to the clubs 90<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. We have much planned over the four days and we hope you enjoy helping us celebrate

As many of you will recall the old Aurora pitch was infamous for its characteristic 'bobble', the nets were held together with tape and tie wraps, and the changing rooms were tatty. That said it was our home. Our exile to Westfield Sports Centre, Sheffield took its toll on the membership, particularly the youth where numbers dwindled forcing us to make partnerships with other clubs to get players a regular game.



The Club's management committee has worked tirelessly since the move to secure a partnership deal to provide a home for the Club, in Rotherham, for years to come. Our new facility is a dedicated artificial hockey pitch, meeting England Hockey's standards for top-flight hockey. It also includes disability access, a refurbished spectator stand, welfare facilities, floodlighting, landscaping and car parking. We also have use of the excellent Graham Solley Pavilion just next door, for changing facilities and refreshments.



We hope that this move not only provides a first-class base for us to provide competitive hockey for our men, women, and young people but that at the same time it will allow us to work towards our objectives of promoting the game through education, involvement of the local community, and player development for all ages and abilities.



As well as the hard work and time the club's management has dedicated to this move, it would not have been possible without the donations and funds raised by club members and associates. All players have paid an annual levy on top of subs for the past few years, players from the men's 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> team ran the Total Warrior event raising sponsorship money, social events organised by Matt Webb and Sue Downs such as the race night raised thousands and donations from members, VP's and life members all contributed to the fund.

Finally, we must thank our volunteers and very generous event sponsors, without who these events would not be possible.

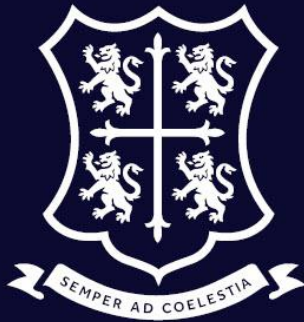

## Club Development

My role as Development Officer is to help the club to grow and develop. This will be accomplished by getting people into the club; youth and senior, not just to play, but also to coach, umpire and volunteer.

Primarily, I will be working to strengthen our links with Schools in Rotherham and South-East Sheffield. I will achieve this by going into schools and taking sessions in curriculum time and at after school clubs. Additionally, I will be working with teachers to give them the knowledge and confidence to lead hockey sessions that are safe and fun. I will also be going into special schools in Rotherham, with the aim of starting a special needs section of the club.

I am not only working with children, but adults too. Sessions such as Back to Hockey, which is aimed at beginners, and Rush Hockey, which are small sided games, are intended to offer hockey to people who do not want to play competitively and may not want to join a club. I will also be working with companies like Active Rotherham, to provide hockey at their events.

I will be working to offer courses and qualifications for both Hallam students and our own club members and will be working with Sheffield Hallam University to offer their students volunteer opportunities within our club.
