Whilst you are enjoying the facilities we have to offer, we would ask you to be mindful of the need to maintain these grounds for future users in excellent condition. In particular, we seek your support with the following actions;

- All users must agree to conduct themselves according to the rules and within the requirements of the Licensing Act 2003 and applicable Health & Safety legislation.
- Any acts of vandalism that causes damage needing to be repaired will be paid for by the organisation or individual hiring the premises.
- Please report any damage immediately to the bar manager/staff.
- Alcohol must not, in any circumstances, be purchased or consumed by anybody under the age of 18. The club by law operates the Challenge 25 policy that may require people to prove their age.
- Smoking and vaping is only permitted in the designated areas. Please discard of any cigarette ends in the provided bins.
- Children under the age of 16 must be under the direct supervision of a responsible adult.
- Please park thoughtfully allowing space for others to enter or leave.
- No animals, other than guide dogs are permitted inside the premises.
- When leaving the premises, please show consideration for our neighbours by keeping noise to a minimum.
