## Annual Notice of Race 2022

(all Friday night series racing, out-of-harbour races and in-harbour weekend races)

### **Rules:**

All races will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the RYA, the EDSC Sailing Instructions and the Notice of Race.

### **Organising Authority:**

East Dorset Sailing Club is the organising authority for all the series racing and individual races specified in Club Racing Calendar.

### **Dates and times:**

The specified dates, times and events are posted on the club website calendar but may be subject to amendment. Please see EDSC website for updated information.

### **Eligibility:**

Any member of East Dorset Sailing Club or Lilliput Sailing Club is invited to enter the Friday evening series and Cruiser out-of-harbour races. Competing boats must be helmed by a member of EDSC or LSC, however the helm may be taken temporarily by another hand. Eligibility for trophy races shall be determined by the conditions of that trophy. Dinghies must register their PY handicap and sail number, Cruisers must register their PHHS handicap and sail number.

**Entry requirements:** All boats must register with the Race Officer for the relevant series or race (together with a Junior Waiver Form, if applicable). Competitors in the Candelabra Trophy must complete an entry form and pay the entry fee.

**Cruiser Handicap:** Each boat shall hold a valid PHHS handicap for the relevant series or race.

**Personal buoyancy:** All dinghy sailors and competitors under the age of 18 years shall wear adequate personal buoyancy at all times whilst afloat. It is strongly recommended that all adult sailors shall wear adequate personal buoyancy whilst afloat.

**Insurance:** All boats must have valid Third Party Liability Insurance in excess of £2,000,000.
