2022-23 SEASON OUTLOOK

The Toledo men's tennis team embarks on its 26th season with head coach Al Wermer this January. After graduating one Rocket last spring, eight return from the 2022 MAC Championship runner-up team with the addition of one freshman.

Wermer enters the 2022-23 season with an overall record 299-335 record, the winningest men's coach in Toledo history.

"I think it's going to be wild ride this year," Wermer said. "Our seniors are very motivated and excited. Our non-conference schedule, beginning with this opening weekend, will provide a litany of challenges to help brace us for MAC play. The schedule, as usual, includes a great mix of Power-5 teams including No.2 Ohio State next weekend, with another handful of teams at the top of their respective conferences. They know how to win, and I think the team will love the rocky ride."

ABOUT THE ROCKETS

Reigning MAC Player of the Year and First-Team All-MAC honoree Pawit Sornlaksup returns for his junior season at the No.1 position.

Sornlaksup registered a team-best 22-2 singles record with

an unblemished 10-0 mark against conference opponents this season, ending the year on a 22-match win streak from the No. 1 court. He also notched a doubles record of 16-2 (8-0 MAC) from the top court with Galic. Sornlaksup collected six weekly MAC Player of the Week honors, four for singles play and two for doubles performances. He was ranked the No. 124 DI men's singles player in the ITA's fall collegiate tennis rankings.

Toledo's senior class includes MAC All-Tournament Team honoree Marko Galic, Second-Team All-MAC honoree Krzysztof Wetoszka, as well as Luka Jankovic, Luis Kleinschnitz, and Max Skaer.

Galic earned a 17-6 overall singles record from the No.6 court, 9-1 in conference play, and ended the season on a nine-match win streak. In doubles competition with Sornlaksup, the duo went on a 13-match doubles win streak from Feb. 25 – Apr. 23. Galic recorded the lone win for the Rockets vs. Indiana, and secured the match point in Toledo's 5-2 vs. Dayton.

Wetoszka earned a 14-9 singles record with a 7-3 mark in MAC play from the No. 3 court, and had a five-match win streak from Mar. 19 – Apr. 8. Wetoszka and doubles partner Cole Shoults went 9-9 (4-3 MAC) from the No. 2 court.



Junior Adam Kovac makes a return to the No.2 court, after receiving Second-Team All-MAC honors with Wetoszka. Kovac produced a 10-13 overall singles record with a 6-3 mark vs. MAC opponents. From the No.3 doubles court, Kovac went 13-9 (5-5 MAC) mostly with Jankovic.

The newest addition to the roster is freshman Matias Olivero from Santiago, Chile.

THE SCHEDULE

This season, the Rockets have a hefty non-conference schedule, starting with Boston University on Saturday, Jan. 14. The Rockets' non-conference home slate includes Youngstown State, Wayne State, Duquesne, and Chicago State. The road matchups are comprised of Indiana (Jan. 15), Ohio State (Jan. 19), IUPUI (Feb. 4), Dayton (Feb. 11), Xavier (Feb. 12), and Purdue (Feb. 26).

Wermer and his team will host its Alumni Day in Orlando, Fla. at the USTA National Campus to conclude the non-conference schedule.

"Our dual non-conference season is loaded with several Big Ten teams including behemoth Ohio State, and a handful of others who are also at the top of their respective conference like Dayton, Youngstown State, Wayne State, and Xavier," Wermer added. "If things fall our way, those matches will help prepare us for another great MAC season and run at a MAC Championship in late April."

Upon their return, the Rockets will begin MAC dual competition beginning Mar. 11 vs. Ball State in Muncie, Ind. All MAC programs will play each other twice this season, one home and one away match.

The 2023 MAC Men's Tennis Championships will be hosted by 2022 champion Western Michigan on April 22-23 in Kalamazoo, Mich.

The NCAA Championships will take place in May, with the team competition scheduled for May 5-7, and the individual competition scheduled for May 22-27.



Toledo swept Marquette in a non-conference match on Feb. 18 in Milwaukee, Wisc. and sparked a five-match win streak. The Rockets finished runner-up at the 2022 conference tournament and had a 15-9 (7-3 MAC) record.

Head Coach *Al Wermer*



Al Wermer is the winningest men's coach in any sport at the University of Toledo, with 299 victories in his 26 years at the helm of the men's tennis program. Coach Al, as he is referred to by his athletes, has coached 34 Rockets to All-MAC honors and led his team to 11 Mid-American Conference Tournament finals or semi-finals appearances.

Wermer's team is coming off a 2021-22 season in which his team recorded a 15-9 (7-3 MAC) record and appeared in the finals of the Mid-American Conference Tournament. The Rockets also finished second in the regular season, and collected numerous postseason accolades. Pawit Sornlaksup was named Player of the Year, Marko Galic and Sornlaksup were named to the All-Tournament Team, three Rockets earned All-MAC honors, and Cole Shoults was named the league's Jack Verdevelt Sportsmanship Award honoree.

Toledo was ranked No. 9 in the 2022 ITA Collegiate Tennis Division I Men's Great Lakes Regional Rankings, following the 2021-22 season. Additionally, Sornlaksup was ranked No. 17 in singles, and Sornlaksup and Galic were ranked No. 8 in doubles.

In the classroom, the Rockets have earned 20 Academic All-MAC awards and 14 Academic All-MAC Honorable Mentions accolades. Under Wermer, his team has earned an ITA All-Academic honor and four Rockets were recognized as Scholar-Athletes in 2021 and 2022.

During Coach Al's tenure, he has coached an ITA Midwest Regional Arthur Ashe Leadership Award winner, an ITA Midwest Regionals singles semi-finalist, five MAC Players

of the Year, three recipients of the MAC Senior Sportsmanship Award, and two Toledo Varsity T Hall of Fame student-athletes. Those Hall of Fame athletes include Jared Miller (2018) and Stjepan Sisko (2022).

Coach Al has served many terms as the Intercollegiate Tennis Association (ITA) Division I Midwest Men's Regional Chairman and on the ITA National Division I Operating Committee, developing policy for college tennis. He is a regular speaker at national and regional tennis coaches' conventions.

Coach Al has focused on enhancing facilities and numerous community engagements at the University of Toledo, making Rocket Tennis relevant on campus and in the community. He's been instrumental in two major tennis facility upgrades, as well as the renovating the men's tennis locker room.

Wermer founded the Rocket Tennis Dream Academy in 2017 for under-served youth. He's also directed cancer awareness initiatives, free kids clinics and pro-am events.

Wermer, a graduate of Capital University with a degree in physical education, played one season on the pro circuit. Coach Al began his college coaching with his alma mater, the Crusaders. He received his Master of Arts in recreation and leisure studies from Toledo and a second Master's degree in sport psychology.

Wermer and his wife, Nancy, have been married for 26 years.

Graduate Assistant Coach *Igor Kolaric*



Igor Kolaric enters his second season as the graduate assistant coach for the University of Toledo men's tennis program in 2022-23.

In his first season on staff, Kolaric helped Toledo achieve a record of 15-9 (7-3 MAC) record and reach the finals of the Mid-American Conference tournament. The Rockets also finished second in the regular season, and collected numerous postseason accolades. Paw-it Sornlaksup was named Player of the Year, Marko Galic and Sornlaksup were named to the All-Tournament Team, three Rocketss earned All-MAC honors, and Cole Shoultz was named the league's Jack Verdevelt Sportsmanship Award honoree.

Toledo was ranked No. 9 in the 2022 ITA Collegiate Tennis Division I Men's Great Lakes Regional Rankings, following the 2021-22 season. Additionally, Sornlaksup was ranked No. 17 in singles, and Sornlaksup and Galic were ranked No. 8 in doubles.

A native of Birkenfeld, Germany, Kolaric was a star player for

Illinois State and Hawaii. During his two seasons at ISU, Kolaric led the Redbirds with a 32-18 singles record and 19-13 doubles record, mainly playing at the No.1 position. He received Summit League Player of the Year, Newcomer of the Year and all-conference honors in 2018 and was an all-conference and all-academic honoree in 2019. Kolaric played for one year for the Rainbow Warriors at Hawaii.

At one point in his playing career, Kolaric was ranked No. 2 for players under 18, No.10 overall in Germany, as well as No. 1,639 in the world. He played for the Serbian Junior National Team, won one International Tennis Europe singles title and one doubles title. Kolaric played for TC Wolfsberg Club in 2015 and Z. Bundesliga. He was an ITA Oracle Master Participant and his highest UTR was 13.21. Kolaric also was the hitting partner for ATP's No.26 Filip Krajinovic.

Before coming to Toledo, Kolaric served as the head tennis coach at Bloomington Tennis Center in 2019, and then went on to be the tennis director for two tennis clubs in Germany in 2020.

Kolaric is currently finishing his master's degree at Toledo.
