2022 RULES AND REGULATIONS

British Gymnastics regulations as published in the 2022 National WTC Competition Handbook and 2022 Regional WTC Competition Handbook will apply to all H.G.A. competitions with any exceptions detailed in this handbook.

Coaches and Club Leaders who wish to enter gymnasts to a Herts event are asked to read and take note of the following information for all Artistic competitions. For all General Gymnastic competitions please refer to the ECGA General Gymnastics Competition Handbook

All coaches must have a current DBS and a Safeguarding & Protecting Children Certificate before being allowed to accompany gymnasts at competition

Apparatus:

Competition apparatus available at Marriotts is to current FIG specification. Therefore, clubs may not bring their own equipment to the competition venue, unless this is the hand placement mat for a Yurchenko vault. Any apparatus queries and requests must be made at least 7 days before the date of competition.

Code of Conduct

The Regional Code of Conduct is applied across all disciplines and to all members of the region. Coaches and gymnasts are also subject to the code of conduct as detailed in the current Code of Points.

Competition Entry

Forms will be available to download from the county website and should be submitted by the closing date stated on page 7. All competitions will be held at Marriotts Gymnastics Centre, Stevenage. Should the Treasurer not receive the entry fee by the entry closing date as stated on the entry form, the late entry fee will be applied.

Please note there is currently no spectators allowed at Competitions in 2022 due to the Covid-19 protocol of the sports centre. As and when rules change this will be communicated to clubs.

<u>Fees</u>

Competition entry fee is £20.00 for all 2022 competitions. Payment by BACS in the name of the **Club** not individual name entry. The entry fee should be made from the club account using the reference as stated on the entry form. Entry Fees are non-refundable once the closing date has passed.

Gymnasts

Gymnasts who qualify from a County qualifier to a Regional final will need to be entered by the club and pay the entry fee for their qualifying gymnasts direct using BG's online system. Following the results of the regional finals clubs will receive a refund of entry fee for each gymnast that competes in the final from the county treasurer. Gymnasts who do not compete on all apparatus (apart from injury on the day) will not have a county refund.

Should a gymnast, who qualified for a final become injured, the club should contact the appropriate reserve and notify the Regional Competition Organiser and County Treasurer.

Coaches

When submitting entries for a BG event each club must ensure that the coaches attending to the participants are qualified to the level of the participants' performance. The practice of supervising participants working above the level of the coach's qualification cannot be condoned.

The caveat that permits coaches to practice one level above their coaching qualification in the coaching syllabus refers to a training environment only and is not permitted at BG events. Coaches who have a Level 1 qualification are allowed to provide pastoral care under the supervision of a Level 2 or above coach.

Apart from as required for the running of the competition, gymnasts, coaches, judges and officials must not use mobile phones or any other electronic communication devices including tablets in the main arena during the event.

*LEVEL 1 COACH - Must be under the direct supervision of at least a Level 2 or above qualified coach and may only coach to the level of their qualification. Jewellery/Chewing Gum

Body piercing, adornments and chewing gum is not permitted at training sessions and in the competition arena. Wedding rings must be covered with tape.

Judges

All clubs must provide at least 1 qualified judge for all county competitions/grades in which their gymnasts have been entered.

Clubs who fail to provide a qualified judge will be denied entry to county competitions. Judges must be aware that they should be available for all rounds of the days competition however this does not need to be the same Judge from the Club for all rounds. Clubs should be prepared to provide more than one judge when entering competitions; if there is insufficient available then the competition will have to be cancelled. If judges outside of the County are being proposed this will need to be approved by our judging convenor (gtovey@btinternet.com) and treasurer (treasurer.hga@gmail.com).

County Events

In County competitions leading to qualification for a regional final the following criteria applies to a coach accompanying gymnasts.

1. The coach must hold a minimum qualification of Level 2 coach or above in the sports specific discipline and must hold an award appropriate to the skills being performed by the gymnast.

In individual competitions 1 coach per gymnast is allowed on the competition area at any one time.

As per the BG handbook removal of leotards in the competition arena is not allowed.

All coaches who are in the competition arena must wear a tracksuit and collared polo shirt or club T-shirt and tracksuit bottoms with suitable footwear. No shorts or backless footwear allowed.

The competition organiser must be informed in advance where it is necessary to substitute a coach or judge.

Welfare Officers for the Competition will either be Glynis Tovey, Teresa O'Neill or Katrina Smith for WAG/MAG competitions.

The Competition Organiser will collect in County trophies for engraving, these must be returned by the date requested so that they are ready to given out at this year's competition. It is the responsibility of the club of the gymnast at the time of winning the trophy to ensure it is returned by the requested date, there will be an administration fee if this is not adhered to.

Music

Clubs are required to send gymnasts music to the competition organiser with **the entry**, failure to do this may result in music not being available at the competition. The music must show the name of the gymnast and club. This can be emailed to comps.hga@gmail.com

MEMBER CLUBS - Clubs must ensure all gymnasts and members have current British Gymnastics membership and affiliate all eligible members to the region.

Competition Covid-19 Procedures

It is requested that all gymnasts, coaches and officials complete a lateral flow test within the 24 hours prior to each competition. If your test result is positive, you should follow the most recent Government guidance and should not attend the competition. Any volunteer officials or judges should notify the competition organiser as early as possible if they record a positive result by emailing comps.hga@gmail.com.

Comps.hga@gmail.com should also be emailed if a gymnast is not attending due to a positive Covid test copying in treasurer.hga@gmail.com and a refund will be arranged in due course.

No spectators are allowed into the Sports Centre/Gymnastics Arena. Coaches should collect the gymnasts from outside the main door of the sports centre and escort them to the gym. Coaches should then deliver the gymnasts back to parents after the competition who should wait in the car park.

One additional coach per club will be permitted to attend the competition to video performances. They must remain in the designated area and should not enter the gymnastic arena during the competition. They must be BG affiliated and dressed in club clothing. The name and BG number of this person must be emailed to the competition organiser 7 days before the competition.

On entry to the gym on the day of competition all gymnasts, coaches and officials will be expected to sanitise their hands with the gel provided and also as they rotate round pieces.

Any queries with regard to Covid-19 protocol should be submitted to the competition organiser no later than 7 days prior to the competition date.

If clubs are intending to enter more than 20 gymnasts across all levels at this competition, they must request permission from the Competition Organiser (comps.hga@gmail.com) who reserves the right to cap at 20 depending on total entry. This notification must be received two weeks before the official closing date.

Minimum age is 6 in the year of competition. For details of exercise see published HGA Grades booklet.

Certificates for this competition are preprinted as per the programme. Any errors must be notified to the competition organiser no later than 7 days before the competition date.

Club/Regional Grades 6 - 1 - 10th April

Open to gymnasts as described in the National Development Club Grades handbook 2020.

Age groups: Grade 6 age groups 8, 9/10 & 11+

Grade 5 age groups 9, 10/11 & 12+ Grade 4 age groups 10, 11/12 & 13+ Grade 3 age groups 11/12 & 13+ Grade 2 age groups 12/13 & 14+ Grade 1 age groups 13/14 & 15+

Current British Gymnastics Grades regulations apply. A Certificate will be presented to each gymnast who pass their respective grade. Certificates for this competition are preprinted as per the programme. Any errors must be notified to the competition organiser no later than 7 days before the competition date.

County qualifier to regional finals with first 3 gymnasts at each grade in each age group entered to the finals to be held at Pipers Vale on Sunday 8th May

Women's & Men's Artistic Novice & Intermediate County Apparatus Competition – 12th June

If clubs are intending to enter more than 30 gymnasts across all levels at this competition, they must request permission from the Competition Organiser (comps.hga@gmail.com) who reserves the right to cap at 30 depending on total entry. This notification must be received two weeks before the official closing date.

2022 - Women's Artistic Individual Novice Apparatus Competition

Eligibility: Gymnasts who have not competed in a 4-piece County voluntary competition.

Gymnasts who have taken part in the current NDP Grades cannot enter this event.

Open to gymnasts who do not train more than 4 hours a week

Age Groups: 7/8 9/10 11/12 13+

Coach qualification: Minimum General Gymnastics Club Coach Award (Level 3 coach) or Women's Artistic Coach Award (Level 2).

2022 - Women's Artistic Individual Intermediate Apparatus Competition

Eligibility: Gymnasts who have not competed in a 4 piece County individual voluntary competition other than county Level 6 individual

Gymnasts who have taken part in the current NDP Grades cannot enter this event.

Open to gymnasts who do not train more than 6 hours a week

Age Groups: 7/8 9/10 11/12 13+

Coach qualification: Minimum General Gymnastics Club Coach Award (Level 3 coach) or Women's Artistic Coach Award (Level 2).

2022 - Men's Artistic Individual Novice Apparatus Competition

Eligibility: Gymnasts with a minimum of BG bronze membership who have not competed in a 4 piece County voluntary competition other than county Level 6 individual or HGA Grades. Gymnasts who have taken part in the current NDP Grades cannot enter this event.

Open to gymnasts who do not train more than 4 hours a week

Age Groups: 6 7/8 9/10 11/12 13+

Coach qualification: Minimum General Gymnastics Club Coach Award (Level 3 coach) or Women's Artistic Coach Award or Men's Artistic Coach Award (Level 2).

2022 - Men's Artistic Individual Intermediate Apparatus Competition

Eligibility: Gymnasts with a minimum of BG bronze membership who have not competed in a 4/6-piece individual voluntary competition other than county Level 6 individual or HGA Grades. Gymnasts who have taken part in the current BDP Grades cannot enter this event.

Open to gymnasts who do not train more than 6 hours a week

Age Groups: 7/8 9/10 11/12 13+

Coach qualification: Minimum General Gymnastics Club Coach Award (Level 3 coach) or Women's Artistic Coach Award or Men's Artistic Coach (Level 2). If Boys are opting to use a metal bar this should be notified to the Competition Organiser when the entry is submitted.

Gymnasts can enter any 1, 2, 3 or 4 pieces of apparatus with medals awarded for each. Overall medals will also be awarded at this competition.

WAG - Gold, Silver, Bronze & Level 7 County Individual Championship - 18th September

Gold, Silver and Bronze is open to gymnasts with BG Silver membership. Please note that you cannot enter voluntary levels and classic challenge in 2022. Level 7 is open to gymnasts with BG Bronze or Silver membership who have not competed in a County 4-piece competition (excluding HGA Grades).

As per 2021 Women's Artistic Classic Challenge Championships rules and the 2022 Herts Competition booklet.

Age groups

Level 7 - 7/8, 9/10, 11/12 and 13+ (should there be insufficient entries in 13+ age group, the county reserves the right to revert to an 11/12+ age group).

Bronze - 10, 11/12 and 13+

Silver - 12/13 and 14+

Gold – 14/15 and 16+

MAG - Level 7 & 6 County Individual Championship - 18th September

Level 7 open to gymnasts with BG Bronze or Silver membership who have not competed in a County or Regional competition (apart from recreational apparatus event/general gymnastics competition) for boys. Level 6 open to male gymnasts with BG Bronze or silver membership. Age taken as attained in the year of competition.

Age groups

Level 7 7/8 9/10 11/12 13+ (should there be insufficient entries in 13+ age group, the county reserves the right to revert to an 11/12+ age group.

Level 6 7/8 9/10 11/12 13+

Zinc & Copper County Individual Championship – 25th September

Open to gymnasts with BG Silver membership. Please note that you cannot enter voluntary levels and classic challenge in 2022

As per 2021 Women's Artistic Classic Challenge Championships rules Age Groups
Zinc - 8, 9/10 and 11+
Copper – 9, 10/11 and 12+

First three placed gymnasts in each age group go forward to regional finals 30th October at Pipers Vale.

WAG - Copper, Bronze, Silver & Gold Teams - 9th October
