Sullivan Town Parks Information

SULLIVAN PARK - 319 Lake Street, Chittenango - Open from 9:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. Rest rooms are available. Two pavilions are available by reservation from early May to early October. A Disc Golf Course is open during park hours.

CHAPMAN PARK - 1463 Route 31, Bridgeport between Bridgeport and Lakeport - Open daily from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Rest rooms are available. Three pavilions are available by reservation. The dog park includes a large fenced in area divided into two sections where small and large dogs can be free to run safely off leash under the watchful eyes of their owners.

PARK SECURITY - Sullivan Park is patrolled on a regular basis by the Chittenango Village Police, NYS Police and the Madison County Sheriff Department. Sullivan Park also has a caretaker on duty. Chapman Park is patrolled by the NYS Police and Madison County Sheriff Department. Our facilities are also monitored by our Park Personnel. Emergency telephones are available in both parks.

BOCCE COURT - Sullivan Park has a bocce court open during park hours.

TENNIS COURTS - Each park has three public tennis courts open during park hours. Leagues and lessons may limit the use of the courts at certain times.

BALL FIELDS - Sullivan Park has a softball field & sand volleyball court. Chapman Park has 2 softball fields, a sand volleyball court & 4 soccer fields. Leagues have priority.

WALKING TRAILS - Sullivan Park has numerous marked Healthy Heart walking trails. Chapman Park has a one-mile marked walking trail.

Summer is over; it certainly has been an old-fashioned one – hot and dry! We are upon budget season again for the Town Board, and I anticipate no or very minimal changes to the budget. There are some capital projects that need to be done, like parking lots. The parking lot at Sullivan Park definitely needs to be redone, along with widening of the Chapman Park driveway to the lake.

In September, we will be dredging the pond in Sullivan Park, installing a retaining barrier and building up the low spot by the pavilion.

We have been working on the Salt Springs Water District, among others. Funding from agencies is always a challenge, with scoring methods favoring larger projects. There is a lot of talk in Washington regarding infrastructure funding – water, sewer, roads, bridges. I suspect something will be done at the federal level in the next couple of

In March, we lost an institution in Elwin "Sonny" Centner. At that time, the Town Board asked me to oversee the department, along with my duties as Town Supervisor and County Chairman. Not one to shy away from a challenge, I agreed to do it until the end of the year for no compensation, saving the Town about \$100,000 for 2016. The Highway Superintendent job is very busy, not driving equipment but keeping 10 men busy, scheduling work, making sure the budget is kept in check, and loads of paperwork.

Home owners who recently purchased or recently built their homes will need to apply for the STAR exemption with New York State.

The new law only affects new owners or new construction. To apply contact the State at www.tax.ny.gov. Click on changes to STAR "learn more"

The STAR exemption gives owner occupied residences a discount on their school taxes.

Once you have registered make sure to retain your confirmation number.

Summer Fire Safety

One of the big fire safety suggestions is caution in the use of gas cooking grills and use of portable and window air conditioners.

Do not use gas grills near your house; move them at least 10 feet from siding, never use them inside your garage or

inside any dwelling.

Air conditioners should not be used on an extension cord. Plug them directly into an outlet; a separate, dedicated circuit is your best bet.
