4: TECHNICAL MANUAL UPDATE

BHPA Technical Manual amendment 20 has now been published on the BHPA website and can be found under the Schools > Documents tab, along with the now superseded Amendment 19. All licence holders are to review the amendment schedule to see if their operation is affected.

Amongst the amendments is a requirement for new and renewing dual licensed pilots to have a valid first aid certificate, and a requirement for all new paraglider dual licence applicants (including Air Experience Instructors) to have completed an Advanced Glider Control course (SIV). As a result of the Covid restrictions, the FSC has decided to delay the implementation of these tandem pilot requirements until 1st January 2022. They are written into the Technical Manual at this stage to ensure dual pilots (and those training dual pilots) are suitably prepared for implementation from the beginning of next year.

5: GREEN DRAGONS: LEARN TO FLY ZOOM MEETINGS

Andy Shaw, CFI at the Green Dragons training school, will be dedicating an evening each week to a public-facing Zoom meeting for would-be free fliers.
