2nd All Around (Individual), 2nd for the Team and two individual medals, 1st on Bars and 2nd Vault. **Mia Scott** was Selected to represent England at the Leverkusen Cup in October and once again a silver medal came back to Durham – 2nd in the Team Competition. Most recently a brilliant



competition for **Charlotte Moralee** in the National Junior Challenge Cup! Despite a couple of uncharacteristic falls from the beam Charlotte still managed to finish in a fantastic 6th overall and 4th on Bars! Then at **National Voluntary Levels** competition gymnasts also brought home medals!. At Level 3 Keira Pedelty placed 12th AA, 1st Bars, 7th Combined and at Level 4 Claire Smith 43rd AA, 21st Combined; Rose Cole 35th AA, 25th Combined. Level 4 North Team placed 9th

Have a look at the photos of the old and the new place and you'll see why we are so excited!!!!


TeamGym News from City of Newcastle.....

We then turned our attention to the Newcastle Team Gym Open which was a resounding success for home teams and visiting competitors alike with excellent results across the day. 
