#### 3. Update on actions from last meeting

Priory Island markings have been done  
 Funding for speed monitoring now come through. Work commencing imminently.  
 Will be average speed cameras.  
 Tenders for structural survey on Leisure Centre due back 7<sup>th</sup> September.  
 Will be some bus service improvements from 1<sup>st</sup> September.

#### 4. Update on Action Plan

Fencing being repaired at landfill site. Was stressed this is not public land.  
 Landfill site not been handed over yet as doesn't meet required standards.  
**ACTION: IT to report back**

#### 5. Neighbourhood Watch / Police and Crime Update

Sue Sambells gave update (copy attached).  
 Discussion on U turns at Derby Road / Thoresby Road, and Arundel Drive.  
**ACTION: SC to speak with Highways Agency / County Council.**  
 Discussion on siting of crossings causing problems with schoolchildren. SC indicated that Highways Agency had refused to put in crossings as there had been no incidents.  
 Possibility of a petition for crossing.  
**ACTION: IT and SC to organise a petition for a crossing at Thoresby Road and SC to present to County / Highways Authority.**

**6. Café in the Park update**

Malcolm Gent gave update. Original application for charitable status had failed as project was seen as “commercial”. Subsequent application put in on basis of Bramcote and Stapleford Community Hub. Was accepted. Detailed plan is needed. Also, have to get 30 year lease in order to apply for funding. Request for extra help as work falling on 4 people. Particularly need help on social media aspect.

**7. White Hills Park Trust update**

Paul Heery gave update. Exam results improved. Very positive and schools seen to be in good health. Design for new school complete. To be signed off this week. Will now go for planning approval with expected start summer 2020. 60-70 week build time. 30 weeks demolition of old buildings after that. Plans and artists impressions presented. County Council financing scheme.  
The meeting expressed thanks to Paul and his team for the very positive work they are doing.

**8. Neighbourhood Plan**

Reported that the plan has been submitted to the Council. Nothing further to report at this stage.  
Discussion around potential flooding issues.

**9. Residents' issues**

Bramcote Today. IT advised this is a good medium for sharing neighbourhood issues, but politicians won't respond to political comments on the site.

Brindle Rd re-surfacing has not been done.

Brindle Rd – Handley Ave street lights not working.

Western Power had caused a few issues during roadworks.

Speeding is an issue on Brindle Road and from island to White Lion pub.

Speed sign on Town Street has been twisted round

Contractors on roadworks at Thoresby Road were rude.

**ACTION: SC to advise appropriate Director**

Weeds growing on Bramcote Island and pavements

**ACTION: IT to speak with Head of Environment**

Ground under stile near Hemlock Stone is eroding.

Discussion on Alexandrina Plantation. SC informed the meeting he could take no part in this discussion or express an opinion due to being a member of the Planning Committee.

No information available on golf course at this stage.



No planning application outstanding at the moment in respect of potential development on Chapel Street.
