
The Parish of Damerham

	It incorporates a Sub-Post Office - Open Monday, 9.00 am to 16.30 pm and Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday & Friday. 9.00 am to 13.00 pm. <u>The Post Office is closed on Saturdays</u> .	
	The nearest town for general shopping is Fordingbridge which has a wide range of shops including a Co-Op, a Tesco Express, butchers, bakers, several hair-dressers, fast food outlets, pubs & restaurants and DIY shops - and many others.

	There is a small shop attached to the Garage in East End which sells soft drinks, ice cream and confectionery.
