

GODALMING and FARNCOMBE BOWLING CLUB

BYE LAWS

1. **DRESS** Players shall wear flat soled shoes (not crepe) and shall be dressed in white or club colours from the waist upwards and white or grey below the waist. Dress code not compulsory for roll-ups.
2. **BOWLS** All matches shall be played under the Bowls England rules.
3. **TEAM SELECTION** The Selection Committee's decision for all fixtures is final. If any member of the elected Selection Committee is unable to attend for team selection on a Wednesday at 7.30pm. a member of the Executive Committee could be asked to fill the vacancy for that evening, always ensuring that the constitution of the Committee did not alter.
4. **REFRESHMENTS** Alcoholic drinks must not be consumed outside the area enclosed by the fence surrounding the green.
5. **SOCIAL MEMBERS** A person may become a social member after they have been proposed and seconded by a Full member and their application form has been displayed on the Club's Notice Boards for seven days. They shall be permitted to roll-ups during the season. However Club members wives/husbands do not of necessity have to become social members, but are welcome to the facilities of the Club providing they sign the visitors book. Social Members do not have any Voting rights in general meetings.
6. **BANKING** All monies belonging to Godalming & Farncombe Bowling Club shall be banked in Godalming. In the event of the Ladies Section falling to a membership of less than four, their account shall be transferred to the Godalming & Farncombe Bowling Club General Account.
7. **BAR** The Bar Committee have the authority to decide the hours for opening the bar, providing the hours are within those agreed with the Licensing Authority. The Bar Steward may close the Bar at any reasonable time, providing he/she advises members at least thirty minutes prior to the time he/she wishes to close.
8. **COMPETITIONS** Fees for Godalming & Farncombe Club entry into a National, Surrey or West Surrey Competition shall be submitted with entry forms. Competition Forms and fees for Club Competitions shall be handed to a member of the Competition Committee during the month of April.
9. **TEA & PAVILION CLEANING ROTA** These rotas will be posted on the notice board at the start of each season. Members who are unable to fulfil their duty as indicated on either of the 2 lists, should change their duty with another member & indicate the change in the appropriate column. Members on Sunday Tea duties shall be responsible for washing the Table Cloths and Tea towels, and returning them ready for the following Saturday.
10. **AWAY MATCHES** Passengers transported to away matches either at Weekends or Mid week- Drivers may claim their expenses for petrol, by completing one of the drivers expense dockets which are available in the pavilion and handing it to the Treasurer. The Zones are shown in appendix 'A'. The definition of each Zone shall be at the absolute discretion of the Executive Committee, who shall from time to time review each Zone. Passengers should contact their drivers, not later than Friday night to confirm the time and place of pick up, so as to arrive at the ground in time to report to the Captain, and pay their match fees 15 minutes before the start. The first reserve will contact the Captain of the day by noon on the day of the match to determine whether they are required to play.

14. **HOME MATCHES** All selected players including the first reserve will report to the Captain of the day at least 15 minutes before the start, and will at the same time pay to the captain their match fees. If any selected player has not reported by the said 15 minutes, the first reserve will play.
