




Q6 How far do the majority of your members travel to play/train?Please give estimated drive times for the majority of each age group by ticking the relevant boxes



Q8 Does your club have a development plan?








Q10 Does your club have a waiting list?

Q11 If your club does have a waiting list please state approximately how many people are there in each age group?







Q12 Do you anticipate your club growing in the next 5 years?












