PERSONAL ARCHERY CHALLENGES

CLASSIFICATION BADGES

A Classification badge is awarded to a Jolly Archer to recognise the achievement of reaching a qualifying level for the first time.

- Separate schemes are run for Indoor and Outdoor Seasons
- Three qualifying rounds need to be shot in the appropriate season to qualify.
- The progress of current members towards Classification achievements during the current season can be found on the Noticeboard at Jubilee Park and on the Club website under “Club shooting”
- The eligible rounds for each badge differ for age and gender and require certain distances and a certain number of arrows.
- Badges are awarded during the summer season as the qualification is achieved.
- Details of appropriate rounds and the scores required can be found in the Archery GB Shooting Administrative Procedures Section 7 Classification Scheme. This can be found under Governance.

Outdoor Season

- The badges awarded by the club are Bowmen, 1st Class, 2nd Class, 3rd Class
- Master Bowman and Grand Master Bowman are awarded by ArcheryGB
- Classification badges are available for Gentlemen, U18 Gentlemen, U16 Gentlemen, U14 Gentlemen, U12 Gentlemen, Ladies, U18 Ladies, U16 Ladies, U14 Ladies, and U12 Ladies.
- The eligible bow types are Recurve, Compound, Longbow, and Recurve Barebow.
- The qualifying period is a year from January 1st to December 31st

Indoor Season

- The badges awarded by the club are A,B,C,D,E,F,G, and H
- Classification badges are available for Gentlemen (including Junior Gentlemen) and Ladies (including Junior Ladies)
- The ArcheryGB scheme specifies the eligible bow types as Recurve and Compound bows. Jollys have chosen to include Recurve Barebow and Longbow using the Recurve schedule of qualifying rounds.
- The qualifying period is the Jollys Indoor Season which runs from October 1st to March 31st
