PERSONAL ARCHERY CHALLENGES

PROGRESS BADGE AWARDS

The ArcheryGB Progress Awards are designed to provide beginners and younger archers with awards for developing their archery skills.

- 36 arrows are to be shot in ends of 6 arrows (it may be over 1 or 2 sessions)
- A maximum of 12 warm up arrows may be shot per session
- Badges (Gold, Red, Blue, Black and White) are awarded for achieving qualifying scores
- A badge colour can only be claimed once irrespective of age group, or bow style. However, missed colours may be claimed when an archer moves up an age group
- Score requirements vary according to:
 - Age Group- Under 10, Under 12, Under 14, Under 16, Under 18
 - o Gender
 - Bow style-Recurve, Compound, Recurve Barebow, Longbow,
 - Fibreglass bows
 - Face size-122cm, 80cm, 60cm, 40cm
 - Distance shot-10-100yards, 10-90metres
- The scoring method used is 5 zone for yards and 10 zone for metric distances
- Jollys also award Progress Awards to seniors at the end of the Beginners Course. They shoot 36 arrows over 20yards at a 122cm face with a Recurve bow.
- Badges are awarded soon after the qualifying shoot.
