| Bleasby Aircrews Memorial Project Team | £2,000 | This project aims to construct a permanent and accessible paved foundation for the new Bleasby Aircrews Memorial for the 40 names, and other unknown, RAF aircrew men who were killed in flying incidents that happened very close to Bleasby during WWII. The men who were killed in these aircraft crashes came from the UK, Poland, Canada, Australia, Eire and New Zealand, and most were based at RAF Syerston, Nottinghamshire. Research findings have been published on the Aircrews Remembered website, which can be searched globally. The bodies of most of the overseas airmen who died in these incidents are buried at Newark Commonwealth War Graves Cemetery. | Newark and Sherwood |
