

News Update

Welcome to the sixth edition of Crane News.

Hello everyone. Well, we must begin the latest edition by wishing you all the very best of health for 2022 and hope that you all had a wonderful Christmas. As a practice we are feeling so positive about the New Year and despite the demands on general practice not appearing to be abating anytime soon, patient care remains our top priority. In fact, it has become even more of an importance for the survival of the NHS and primary care that as multidisciplinary teams we all collaborate much more efficiently. The nursing team for example is the bedrock of good general practice playing an essential role in vaccinations, contraception, Women's/Men's health and in the successful management of chronic diseases such as diabetes, hypertension, asthma COPD and heart disease. The ongoing care needs of these patients has become increasingly more and more the domain of the nursing team with the GP on hand to extend their advice and experience to the management of those patients with even more complex needs.

At this point it is important to remind our patients that all roles within the practice are vital and contribute to the smooth and efficient delivery of health services. Our reception team for example have an immensely difficult role to perform. Whilst they make every conceivable effort to provide immediate access to GPs this may not necessarily be within their powers to do so as demand may on occasion exceed the finite supply of appointments that can be realistically offered. As highly trained members of the team they are still "human" and when they are subjected to verbal abuse (to which the practice enforces a zero tolerance of) this can result in them experiencing workplace related stress. So, we urge all patients to be mindful of this and reinforce that as highly trained members of the team they will always endeavour to ensure that you are seen by the most appropriate professional as quickly as is possible. Their training has involved them being highly proficient in knowing a portfolio of health services which are available that perhaps you may not be aware of such as Physiotherapy, Audiology, Social Prescribing, District Nursing and pharmacy. By "signposting" you to such services they will ensure that your health needs are met along with your expectations.

Since the last edition we are proud to report that our patient list size continues to grow unabated. For this we extend our thanks to you all as word of mouth undoubtedly plays a big part in this. Though these are very difficult and trying times for us all we wish to reaffirm our commitment to our patients. Our doctors along with our clinical and non-clinical practice staff take immense pride in getting to know our patients. In doing so we get to unearth the health problems that impact their general wellbeing and quality of life and wherever possible treat them and in many cases the generations of the same family that make up our practice list.



PSCOs UPDATE Crime Trends

Happy New Year, I hope that you had a pleasant Christmas break.

ASB

During the month of December, we saw an increase of Anti-Social Behaviour on our

ward; this behaviour included throwing stones/eggs at properties, playing 'knock and run' and kicking doors. Due the high demand caused by this ASB, PCSO's from other rural locations joined the Cefn ward on a temporary basis, which enabled us to increase patrols in target locations, as well as dealing with individuals in a timely manner.

Whilst we are still dealing with reports of ASB, we have seen improvements across the hot-spot locations. We have made some good progress in identifying youths responsible and are dealing with them robustly and formally. Neighbourhood Policing Team Officers have been assigned to interviewing suspects where necessary, referrals are being made to Youth Justice and we have set up joint home visits with the Estate Office for individuals who are residing in local authority housing and are causing repeat ASB within the community.

E-Scooters

Since Christmas, we have seen an increase of youths riding e-scooters in an anti-social manner. We continue to challenge any individuals caught riding e-scooters and have been advising parents about the current law regarding them. A Section 59 Notice was recently issued to one rider, if caught a second time, the scooter may be seized.

WRENBURY DEVELOPMENT CEFN MAWR UPDATE

The site on Wrenbury

Way, Cefn Mawr had been left unfinished since 2007 and was considered a 'blight on the community', having become rodent infested and a target for anti-social behaviour. Having acquired the site, *Wales & West Housing* successfully resubmitted plans to build a total of 34 quality affordable homes for rent, which Anwyl set to work on in June 2021.

Now as we come to the end of January 2022, we are making good progress due to the speed the timber kits have been constructed, plots 1 to 6 brickwork is nearing completion and a further 6 units are currently under construction. Over the next couple of weeks we will have a stockpile of timber off cuts for any of our local residents who wish to collect from site, this will help minimise any waste generated throughout the build, an update will be issued once we have enough for collection in the coming weeks.

We are also holding a coffee morning in February for any residents who wish to come and have a chat and see the progress we have made in person, again an update on this will be issued through a newsletter.

Wrexham Foodbank continues to foodbank provide emergency food parcels and toiletries to those in financial crisis. Visitors can also receive blankets, hot

water bottles, socks, gloves and fuel vouchers thanks to their Winter Support Project. To receive a food parcel you would just need to get a referral from somewhere that can help you with other support too such as your housing officer, social worker, health visitor, community agent, school or the Citizen's Advice Bureau. You can also call the Help Through Hardship free helpline on 0808 208 2138. There are eight centres where parcels can be collected, but if you are unable to get there someone can collect on your behalf, or you can request a home delivery. A new centre has just opened at Plas Madoc Leisure **Centre** on Thursday mornings 10.30-12noon, using the red fire exit door by the main car park. This replaces the one that used to be at the George Edwards Hall Cefn Mawr. Donations to the foodbank can be made at their warehouse on Ruabon Road. open every Tuesday and Friday 10-3pm, or in most supermarket stores.

INDEPENDENCE AT HOME VISITING WARDEN SERVICE

Are you aged over 60?

Do you know anyone over 60? Would you/they welcome a reassuring visit? Then we may be able to help you with our new Visiting Warden Service.



What does the Visiting Warden Service Offer? Our Wardens are experienced in giving advice and support on the many circumstances and issues faced by older people, so they can:

- Call regularly to see that you are well to help you look after your overall health and well-being.
- Help you to contact health services, agencies or anyone else, if your health or wellbeing should change.
- Advise and support in how to get involved in things that interest you. Give information and advice on services that are available to you.

The Visiting Warden cannot help with routine practical tasks, such as cooking, personal care or shopping, however they can provide advice and assistance with getting help with these services. During their first visit the Warden will ask you what help you feel you need, discuss the kind of support that is available and asses how many Warden visits you require. You can have a friend or relative with you at this discussion if you wish.

Who can apply?

The service is available to people aged over 60. You need to be willing to have a Basic Telecare package installed in your home. The Telecare service provides a telephone link, 24 hours a day, 365 days a year between your home and the Telecare Response Centre and enables you to call for help by pressing the pendant or activating a Telecare sensor in an emergency or when you are having difficulties. This service gives you the added confidence of knowing that there will always be someone to contact if you need help

What will it cost?

The current charge for the Visiting Warden is £3.52 per week (Telecare is charged for separately). The charge is reviewed annually. If you receive Housing Benefit you will not have to pay this charge yourself. If you are on a low income you may be eligible for a reduction in the charge and should apply for a financial assessment, which we can assist you with.

WCBC WINTER FUEL SUPPORT SCHEME

Eligible households can claim a one-off £100 payment to provide support towards paying their on-grid winter fuel bills. The payment will be available to all eligible households regardless of whether they pay for their fuel on a pre-payment meter, by direct debit or by paying a bill quarterly.

To check your eligibility and make a claim go to the WCBC website at www.wrexham.gov.uk/service/winter-fuel-support-scheme

Your household will only be eligible if you or your partner have not received a payment under the scheme before. All applications must be received before the 18 February 2022. Payments for successful applications will be made from January through to end of March 2022.







MUMS RELIEF AFTER RADICAL OPERATION PUTS A SMILE BACK ON HER DAUGHTERS FACE

Dawn Harwood, of Rhosymedre, revealed it was the best Christmas present ever for her 11 year old daughter Serenity who shed a tear this Christmas as it was the first Christmas she'd had without being in pain.

Mrs Harwood, as a Mother had had to watch unable to take away the 'unbearable pain' that her daughter had been in due to bilateral CTEV (congenital talipes

equinovarus), commonly referred to as 'club foot'. The condition affected both of her feet and required her to have several surgeries and continuing treatments. Having had 11 years of pain, Serenity decided that she wanted to have a below-the-knee amputation.

The operation took place in November at The Gobowen

Orthopaedic Hospital, and went extremely well and six days later she was able to be discharged home.

Serenity left the hospital with a smile on her face and pain free! She has already returned to school and is due to collect her prosthetic limb early this month (February).

Dawn said: "She's coping really well, the consultant is amazed with the progress she is making which is really good.

She was back at school in Ruabon for the start of the term, the school have been brilliant through everything, with the way they have set things up to accommodate her back into school. Me and her dad are very, very proud of her, she was in hospital for six days and all she had was Calpol and ibuprofen. She's coped really well with her crutches and the walking frame and now all she uses are the crutches and the wheel chair.

She tells me that she doesn't regret it at all, she's constantly got a smile on her face although she did have a little cry over Christmas, as it was the first Christmas she had with no pain."

Dawn has previously spoken about the great pain her daughter has been through in her life and about wanting to raise awareness about the condition, as she herself knew little about it prior to Serenity being born. Now after years of seeing her daughter struggle and battle through the pain, it seems that Serenity is finally pain free. We wish Serenity every success in the future and hopes she keeps sharing that lovely smile.
