The Club's history ... and future

When the Club was established in 1904, it boasted a small timber clubhouse and six grass courts. In the 1930s, the courts were re-laid using shale, and in the early 80s, the clubhouse was extended, adding a new bar, lounge and cloakrooms. In the mid-1990s four courts were laid with a synthetic grass surface, and in 2002 our remaining shale courts were upgraded to all-weather hard courts, with floodlights. Three years ago we planned the next move – to convert three courts to porous macadam-based hard surface, and retain three synthetic grass courts. This was completed in early 2011. Future improvements in the pipeline include upgrades to our Clubhouse plus floodlights for two more tennis courts



During its 100-year history, the Club has been well supported generally, but the death of the landlord in the 1960s caused a financial crisis. To buy the freehold, the Club had to raise a large loan. Economy measures were introduced, which caused many members to move to other clubs.

By 1975, the membership had dwindled to an all-time low of 24, so it was decided to hold a winding-up meeting. However, the majority of members were determined to keep the club going. New local tennis and social members were urgently sought. The clubhouse facilities were also offered to a table tennis club. As membership and finances improved, the club's long-term future was secured, and the freehold mortgage taken out in 1962 was fully paid up.

Today, the Club continues to thrive, with more than 200 tennis members, including over 80 juniors and over 80 social and Table Tennis members. Currently, the Club enjoys an active membership and has a body of volunteers who give their time and energy to support and promote the Club and all its activities.

TOURNAMENTS

All tournament details are posted on the Notice Board.

MATCHES

Up to five Men's teams, four Ladies' teams, two Mixed, Veterans, and Junior teams play in the Surrey Summer and Winter Leagues. If you wish to play in a team or match, contact the Tennis Captain. In addition, friendly matches are arranged throughout the summer.



TENNIS COACHING

Available for individuals and groups, team players, juniors and junior squad groups. Contact the Head Coach.

VISITORS

Members can have a maximum of four visits by guests in each subscription year. The visitor's name must be entered in the Visitor's Book kept in the foyer, and the visitor's fee paid (tennis: Senior £3; Junior £1; Social 50p). The member must collect the fee, and accompany the visitor during their stay in the Club, and shall be liable for their conduct.

FLOODLIGHTS

The Floodlights may be used between 4pm and 9pm, and are operated by meters in the entrance hall, which take half hourly tokens. The floodlit courts must be reserved by completing the diary on the shelf in the entrance lobby.

COURT RESERVATIONS

Each month a notice is displayed on the Notice Board outside the Clubhouse indicating the dates and times of court reservations.

ACCESS TO CLUBHOUSE

All Senior Members may request a key to the Clubhouse and the tennis ball

cupboard. The keys are available for a deposit of £4. Contact one of the Committee members. The clubhouse must be vacated one hour after the bar closes, or by 11pm when the bar is not open.

WHIST

Whist drives are held in the main hall every Monday evening at 7.45pm.

CLOTHING

Players **MUST** wear recognised tennis brand clothing and footwear – NOT leisurewear. The following clothing is not considered suitable: marking trainers, football shirts, jeans, non-tennis sportswear, coloured socks. Members must wear or carry their membership tags whilst on the premises.

Friday: 7.30pm – 11.00pm

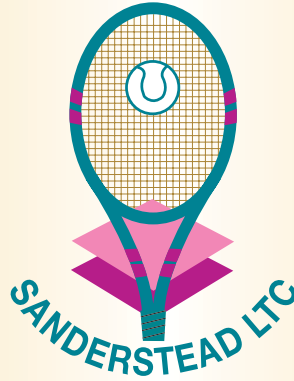
Sunday: 2.00pm – 5.00pm

Children must be accompanied at all times and are required to vacate the lounge at 10pm.

PLAYING HOURS and BEHAVIOUR

9am – dusk (9pm with floodlights).

Members should be courteous to other members, visitors and neighbours. No attempt should be made to retrieve tennis balls from private gardens. Loud or insensitive language should not be used. Smoking, chewing gum and breakables are not permitted on the courts, and court gates should be closed securely when not in use. Players should obtain the consent of other players on court before passing behind them. Litter should be disposed in the bins provided. See notices on Courts for further conduct advice.

MDL: Our Coaching partners
