St Martins Road Play Area

For some time, there have been ongoing problems with anti-social behaviour by youths and vandalism of the remaining equipment within the play area on St Martins Road, which is regularly reported to the local police team. Southern Housing Group propose to install CCTV cameras on the side of block 25-31 St Martins Road, which would capture images of the play area and its perimeter.

We hope that by installing CCTV it will ensure that any further





Dear Residents,

The crack in the surface of the old railway line has been filled in by Island Roads. I have reminded Rights of Way about the handrail and risers on the steps up to the railway line and the maintenance team are aware of this and it will be repaired.

A resident also expressed concern about the entrance to footpath V30 in Castle Road this has also been reported to Rights of Way.

Concerns have been expressed about rubbish being thrown over the wall and into the stream near the seat opposite West Street.

There is a rubbish bin right next to the seat.

Please use it and let's keep Wroxall tidy.

Island Roads have notified me that the St Martins Road car park is to be resurfaced. The start date for the works is Thursday December 5th and will last for one day, weather permitting. If the weather is bad it could go into the next week. Notices will be at the car park entrance.

The pipe coming down Cooks Castle Lane is blocked and I have contacted Island Roads about this. It needs to be attended to because of the volume of water during heavy rain.





The Isle of Wight Donkey Sanctuary is getting ready for it's busiest time of year as we move towards the Christmas Period I Our donkeys are in demand around the island and will be taking part in nativity scenes and Santa events up to and including Christmas Day.

At the sanctuary itself there are 4 main events taking place .

On November 24th we have our Christmas Market . There will be stalls, entertainment and of course our donkeys. Our gift shop will be open for people wanting to buy Christmas Gifts or to adopt a donkey for Christmas ! One difference this year however is that parking will be free ,but restricted and must be booked in advance by calling the office on 01983852693) We recommend that as many people who can come by bus ,cycle or walk should do –we are going to be running a free bus 'hoppa' from Godshill for those who are travelling from further afield.

On each Sunday in December, Santa will be in a Stable , listening to children's thoughts , all aided and abetted by a donkey !
