Ruabon Bowling Club – Season 2022 Round-Up.

Well, the bowling season has once again come to an end and just before the colder autumn weather seems to be moving – good luck rather than good planning, I think.

It's been a mixed season for Ruabon and its league teams this time with some highs and lows but nevertheless all in all a good competitive performance all around.

Wrexham League

Monday night pairs – Ruabon pairs team played in the highest league with the top teams from Wrexham this year so highly competitive! There were some good results during the season particularly at home but unfortunately the team finished second from bottom on 42 points just two points shy of staying up so they will be relegated to the 2nd division next year.

Saturday afternoon singles – Ruabon have a team in the 1st division (Premier division being the highest) and once again it is a highly competitive league. It looked very likely going into the last game that they would also finish second from bottom with Coedpoeth above them by 4 points. However, the last game of the season was away to Coedpoeth with both teams everything to play for. It proved to be a nailbiter with some close fought games but in the end, Ruabon came away with a creditable 9-3 win which meant they leap frogged over Coedpoeth finishing third from bottom and retaining their first division status for next year – A great achievement on the final of season!

Veterans Tuesday afternoon – After the success of promotion last year to the 4th division the Veterans team with a mixture of seasoned players and newcomers has continued to perform above the club's expectations. This year they narrowly missed out on promotion again finishing third and just a couple of points behind Leeswood and Nercwys who have been promoted.

The Veterans team also got to the final of the Division 4 cup final which was played at Llay. They played Gresford Village B and although Ruabon had 5 **(121)** winners to Gresford's 3 **(130)** the final is decided on collective aggregate

scores which is shown red in brackets, so we lost by 9 points. It was disappointing result, but the Veterans have proved they are a good team and will have all to play for next year.

Tuesday Evening singles – Ruabon play in the 2nd division and once again have achieved a creditable position finishing in 4th missing out on promotion by just 15-20 points with away results accounting in the main for the deficit. All to play for again next year.

Autumn/Winter Playing Surface Treatments

With the arrival of the colder weather and the closure of the green for the autumn/winter period it was time to address the green with its winter preparation with reseeded and lawn sand. However, it was felt that the green needed aerating as it had not been done for

almost 10 years – no easy task but one that could not be ignored. The process is called hollow-tining which is the physical removal of cores of turf from the playing surface. (See picture below)



Having cored the greens playing surface the next phase is to rake them up and dispose of the cores which is the hardest task. To make it easier snow shovels were used to push them into rows and then shovel them into plastic bags, a bag breaking job for the 2-volunteer groundsman but members of the Veterans team rallied around and came to lend hand or hands! With their help the job was done in a couple of days and big shout out of “Thanks” goes out to them and everyone involved in that winter season preparation. The picture below shows the work involved and ‘yes’ even veterans wear ‘Hoodies’ 😊

Some 80 or so bags were filled with those cores which would normally have gone in the green bin for land fill but there was just too much. However, the thought occurred that left to rot in the bags it would make excellent compost for next year.



Through the Ruabon Community Agent, the word was spread that some good compost was available for collection if anyone wanted some and there was considerable interest from Ruabon community members and other organisations. To date over 50 bags have been distributed to Ruabon

Community Allotment members, Craft Group members, Bowling Club Members, Ruabon Community Councillors and Brymbo Community Garden Project.

Thanks to all the Ruabon bowlers this year and the volunteers who help to maintain and keep the bowling club running and the green keeper John Edwards who does a marvellous job scheduling and completing the work supported by other volunteers.

Thanks also to Ruabon Community Council for their continued support and financial commitment which every year helps with the machinery maintenance and treatments for the bowling green playing surface which is always on-going. Thanks to Helen Belton – Ruabon Community Council Clerk too for her support over the last few years and we wish her good luck in her similar role in Mold.

One of the earliest worries that were raised with 'Ali' was the hedgerows that had grown so much that the pedestrians – and school children – had to make their journeys' to and from school along the road.

All the hedgerows have now been cut back, apart from those near and alongside the Aldi roundabout, where it has been decided that there must be some planning and traffic restrictions before it can go ahead.

(I think, in order to work with Ali for the pedestrians, we could monitor the time it takes for this suggestion to go ahead)!

The other problem being tackled by Ali at the moment are bus routes, she says. "Bus routes have been brought in by Arriva Wales. We are still having ongoing discussions about more routes and better services with them but this is very slow moving unfortunately. We continue to battle on though."

[Free Welsh Lessons now available for 18-25s and Teaching Staff](#)

Young people and education staff in Wales can now access free Welsh lessons as part of a Welsh Government initiative to increase the number of Welsh speakers. The commitment is part of the Co-Operation Agreement with Plaid Cymru.

18-25 year olds can enrol on Welsh courses with the:

[National Centre for Learning Welsh](#),

and will not be asked to pay when registering.

Free Welsh lessons are also available to all teachers, head teachers and teaching assistants as part of the Welsh Government's efforts to strengthen the teaching of Welsh in the new Curriculum and increase the number of practitioners who can teach in Welsh.

Education staff can access a new [online portal](#) where they can find a suitable course including virtual lessons, face-to-face lessons and self-study courses. The

portal includes a Learning Wizard tool which helps provide a choice of relevant courses.

16-18 year olds at selected schools and Further Education colleges are taking part in a digital learning pilot project, run by the National Centre and “SaySomethinginWelsh”.

Other initiatives for 16-18 year olds include a short online course with the Duke of Edinburgh’s Award and a Welsh confidence-building pilot in Powys with [e-sgol](#).

Evidence and data collected as part of the pilot projects will inform a national scheme for 16-18 year-olds, from 2023.

Jeremy Miles, the Minister for Education and the Welsh Language, said:

“I’m pleased we are increasing the opportunities to learn our language and making it easier for more people to have the opportunity to learn Welsh and use it in their daily lives.

“Growing the number of educators who can teach through the medium of Welsh is key to achieving our aim of a million Welsh speakers by 2050, and this makes it as easy as possible for them to have access to Welsh courses for free. Providing free lessons to 18-25s means that they can continue to develop and improve their Welsh ability and to use the language within their work and social lives.

“Cymraeg belongs to us all. I would encourage all teaching staff and young people who want to learn Welsh for the first time or who want to improve their Welsh to take this opportunity.”

Cefin Campbell MS, Designated Member, said:

“Everyone in Wales should have the opportunity to learn Welsh and experience the cultural and social benefits it brings.

“The rollout of free Welsh lessons for young people and those in the teaching profession is another step towards making it as easy as possible to learn and speak Welsh and to achieve the target for a million Welsh speakers and beyond.”
