

Salvia cedrosensis
Cedros Island Sage

SMALL SHRUB - evergreen.

1 - 2' high, 2' spread.

Low, slenderly branched.

Leaves wooly, gray-green.

Blue or white flowers - spring.

Native habitat: washes and rocky hillsides - Lower Sonoran Zone,
Cedros Island and vicinity of Magdalena Bay, Baja California.

Full sun or part shade. Does not tolerate frost.

Well-drained soil.

Drought tolerant. Water 1 x /month.

Can be grown in a container.

Attracts hummingbirds, butterflies.

Aromatic.
